



WATER CONSERVATION POLICY


“There is a thin line between using water and wasting water”

Water is so important since beginning of life that all the major civilizations formed on the banks of the river in the world. Water is the second most important factor of life after air and our institution has recognized the significance of preserving water.

Arsikere taluk particularly Banavara hobli is one of the seriously drought prone areas. As the summer heat intensifies supply of water through the bore wells become critical and gradually water has gone completely dry. The villages fall in Banavara hobli are the worst drought affected area in Hassan district. At the same time this place is also facing problem of concentration of fluoride in the ground water beyond permissible limit of 1.5 gm/l. Therefore, our college has taken some measures of water conservation.

In order to achieve this institution has adopted following policies.

- Encourage students and staff to carry refillable water bottles.
- Bore-well recharge.
- Maintenance of water bodies and distribution system in the campus.
- Turn off the taps after using it.
- Facilities for Rain Water harvesting.
- Ground water harvesting through rain water pits “Ingu Gundi”.
