SALIENT FEATURES OF THE PROJECT

This project has been initiated in order to create equal opportunities for aspiring college students studying in Hyderabad-Karnataka Region to communicate in English on par with students from other regions, as there is a prevalent sentiment to the contrary.

Though school curricula across the country are designed to achieve a certain competency in English language skills, the same has not been accomplished to a considerable extent. It was therefore felt that there is a need to create an environment wherein students can appreciate the ease with which English can be learned, and proceed to achieve a proficiency such that they readily use English in their day-to-day communications.

The syllabus has been designed to cover all the areas of communication, with the primary focus on language functions and structure. It is structured to unfold the different varieties of language use around the preferred theme. The lessons are so constructed that learners will find it easy and enjoyable to achieve the course objectives.

The salient features of the program are:

1. A single theme runs through all the 60 lessons that make up the course.
2. Language exercises have been built naturally around the theme.
3. Grammatical concepts have also been integrated into the main theme.
4. Primary importance has been given to the functional use of English.
5. Tele-teacher shall teach all the lessons from the studios at Bangalore. These lessons will be beamed simultaneously and directly into the classrooms at all centers.
6. Appropriate technology shall be installed at all the centers to ensure smooth transmission and telecast of the lessons.
7. An open-ended system of interaction allows the learners to contribute to the process.
8. Learners are encouraged to sharpen their creative thinking through these interactions.

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
