Anti Ragging cell

Anti-ragging cell has been formed in the college to address issues related to ranging cases reported by the students, to develop a responsive attitude among the students in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the Institute. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that misconduct by the students is dealt with fairly and provide clear procedure to guide staff and students. To make the institute student friendly and to ensure the qualitative as well as quantitative development of the institution.

Ragging is prohibited under the regulations of UGC Prohibition and Eradication of Ragging Act, 2019. Ragging is a punishable act. Anti-ragging committee will look into ragging issues at college level and to establish measures for prohibiting, preventing and punishing activities of ragging menace within and outside the campus in accordance with UGC regulations. It is responsible for taking action against those found guilty of ragging in any form.

Objectives:

1. To develop institutional framework to address issues related to ragging.
2. To provide an environment for the students where there are no barriers for success and progression.
3. To create an environment where students feel safe, secure and respected.
4. Any misconduct in and outside the college is punishable
5. To bring awareness, impact and the consequences of ragging among the students.

6. The committee will consider and decide on all cases related to ragging within time frame.

Anti-ragging committee: The committee is headed by the Principal with a faculty as coordinator, three faculty as members and a representative from office.

Committee meet as and when the issue arises and take appropriate decision in consultation with other staff members.

Functions:

1. To ensure compliance with regulations with the provisions of UGC and any law in force concerning ragging and deal with the incidents of ragging brought to notice.
2. To bring awareness among students regarding the menace of ragging by giving publicity through posters, invited talks, screening of movies.
3. To conduct inquiry observing fair and transparent procedure after giving adequate opportunity to the students accused of ragging and other witness to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident of ragging.
4. To monitor and observe prevention and curbing of ragging in the institution.
5. To conduct a spot inquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by any of the student or staff or parent or any person as the case may be, an inquiry report along with recommendation to be submitted to the principal.
6. To monitor the welfare of fresh students in and outside the campus.

Action in the event of ragging:

- The institution shall punish the student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure. The Anti-ragging committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision in regard to the incident of ragging depending upon the facts of each incident and gravity of the incident.
- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the of the guilt Anti-ragging committee will follow up the punishment based on the committee's decision.
- The institution can refer to the affiliating university to act according to UGC regulations curbing the menace of ragging.


Punishments:

As per the supreme court judgement on ragging in colleges the following actions will be taken on those who are guilty of ragging

- Withholding of scholarships, free ships, documents like marks card and TC.
- Debarring from appearing for tests/exams and consequent admission to any other institution.
- Suspension or expulsion from attending classes/exams.
- Cancellation of admission or rustication from the institution.
- Registration of FIR against the accused and prosecution under the Indian penal code.
