**DELIBERATION**

Government First Grade College, Frazer Town, Bangalore conducted a 10 day National Level Multi-Disciplinary Online FDP Series on Changing Aspirations in Dynamic Scenario- An Intellectual Deliberation from **8<sup>th</sup> June to 18<sup>th</sup> June 2020**.

The FDP series aimed to provide intellectual deliberations by renowned resource persons on the changing Aspirations in Dynamic Scenario due to changing circumstances in the society. Our FDP program received awesome response from **1398 participants** who have registered for this program from different universities and colleges of Haryana, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Mumbai, Kolkata, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telegana and other states throughout India.

We are also happy to acknowledge the participation from overseas from Muscut. In total, majority of the participants have successfully completed the sessions of Faculty Development Program.

**On 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020 the first day of the program** commenced with invocation song by our visually challenged students. The program was inaugurated by **'lighting the lamp'** by our Principal and all the faculty members.

**Prof. Girish B N**, Department of Commerce, welcomed the Resource person and participants in the inaugural section.

**The key note address was delivered by Dr R. K. Ramesh Babu, Joint Director**, Department of Collegiate Education, Govt of Karnataka, Bangalore. Followed by

the presidential remarks by our principal Prof. M G Vani, dealt on the caption of our FDP ‘Quest for learning is the secret of Success’.

Then after, **the first technical Session** was commenced by speaker **Dr. Roopesh Kumar. A, Assistant professor at Dept of Studies and Research in Library Science, Tumkur University** who addressed on the topic “**Research Visibility and Academic identity**”. This session focused on the research aspects such as citation as a measure of research impact, research visibility through publication in journals with good impact. This information benefited the participants who are in the field of research.

**On second day 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the Resource person **Dr. R. Shashi Kumar, Professor and Chairman, Department of Economics, Jnanabharathi, Bangalore University**, addressed on the topic “**Impact of Covid-19 on the Indian Economy**”. This session highlighted on program and policy of Government of India for handling Covid-19 difficult situation. He emphasized on domestic impact of Covid-19 on various sectors like labour market, Indian Food Industry, Foreign Exchange, MSME, Agricultural sector and Industrial sector. This session enlightened the participants with knowledge of impact of covid-19 on the economy.

**On third day 10<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the Resource person **Prof. B. Gururaj Rao, Students Counsellor of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, Kolar**, threw a light on the topic “**Emotional Intelligence**” relevance to the current situation of Covid-19. In this session, he narrated the ability of person to understand and manage own’s emotions and those of the people around and how these emotions can affect other peoples. The outcome of the session

facilitated the participants to handle the emotions and to improve themselves very strongly.

**On day four 11<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the speaker **Dr. K. Ashok Anand, Founder Director, Sidvin school of Business-Institute of Technology** a well-known administrator addressed on **“Demystifying India’s Economic Stimulus Package- A critical appraisal”** in which he critically analyzed and educated the participants on great depression, Reverse Migration impact, Unemployment level, negative supply shock and Economic stimulus and economic growth. From this area of knowledge participants got valuable inputs.

**On day fifth 12<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the Resource person **Dr Geetha M Rajaram Principal, GIMS Bangalore**, delivered talk on the topic **“Case Study methodology in teaching”** focused on case study with learning objectives for the benefit of the students. The case study teaching methodology was subjected for good interaction by the participants.

**On day sixth 13<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the Resource person **B.V Krishna Murthy AGM (Retd) RBI Bangalore**, delivered the talk on the topic **“Financial Wellbeing ”** that focused on misconception v/s reality of savings, differentiation between the needs and wants, pillars of investment, time value of money and insurance schemes. Participants gained the knowledge about the importance of savings and judging of spending on essential and non essentials.

As a **bonus session on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the speaker **Dr Sudha Khokate Associate Professor, Department of Sociology, Bangalore University, Bangalore**

addressed on the topic “ **Glass Ceiling and Gender Equality- Myth or Reality**”. She described gender equality meaning and reasons of glass ceiling, and breaking of glass ceiling and today’s crises of covid-19. This session imparted knowledge to participants about issues on gender equality, women empowerment in Indian scenario.

**On day seventh 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the speaker **Dr Manjula V Assistant Professor of Sociology, GFGC Kanakapura**, highlighted on the topic “**Sociological Strategies to mitigate impact of covid-19**”. She described the sociological strategies to mitigate impact of covid-19 in terms of threat perception, emotion of risk perception, prejudice and discrimination, physical distancing, localized decision making, social context which have benefited the participants linked to mitigation of impact of covid-19.

**On day eighth 16<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the speaker **Dr Vasudha N Assistant Professor of History GFGC Rmanagara** explained on the topic “**A Bird’s eye view on ‘Wonders that was India**” She illustrated the historical glory of India and covered entire panorama of history which was unknown. Participants were converged to patriotism aspect which was covered in the session.

**On day ninth 17<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, the Resource person **Dr Jayashankara M Assistant Professor of Kannada, GFGC, Harohalli** addressed on the topic “**Manteswami Kaavayada Prasthuthi** ”
