Action Taken Report 2017-18

Outcome in a nutshell: The analysis shows mean values of parameters as rated by students on teachers. The overall results demonstrate that the majority of the students are highly satisfied (as the rating is more than 4) with teachers' preparation, punctuality, methodologies used, leadership skills in teachers, and their availability outside the class.

Simple frequency measure is used for analysis of the feedback about college. It indicates that cultural/NSS/NCC activities (125) have highest **excellent** score followed by availability of principal and his response to students (114) and library facility (104). Playground & sports facilities have highest score as **good** (106). On the other hand, computer facilities (71), disbursement of scholarships (24) and cleanliness (23) in the college have got highest unsatisfactory scores.

Action taken: The aspects pointed out by students are considered with special care and attention. It enabled the head of the institution to appraise teachers. Faculty members were informed about the feedback and encouraged to improvise on all parameters and to strive to keep up the scoring.

The institution made an effort to increase the number of computer laboratory facility in the college. College maintenance measures such as supervision over house-keeping workers etc. were strengthened.


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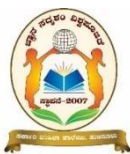
Action Taken Report 2018-19

Outcome in a nutshell: The mean score for all faculty members is greater than 3.5 for feedback on teachers, which indicates that students are satisfied with teachers. All ten parameters have been rated as very good and excellent. This shows that students are contented with teachers and methodologies adopted by teachers. And the analysis of feedback about college revealed satisfactory response about all parameters except computer facilities, disbursal of scholarship and cleanliness.

Action taken: Based on the above analysis, the head of the institution and concerned staffs have taken measures to overcome the drawbacks.

- Faculties were appraised by the head of the institution through one-on-one meeting and advised to improve their teaching skills, update teaching methodologies, to use ICT tools, to involve students through class room discussions and other activities. This would help teachers to gain better scoring in consecutive feedbacks.
- Actions are taken to increase the number of computers in the college.
- Faculty members were advised to take more remedial classes for students.
- The number of house-keeping workers have been increased by recruiting new worker to keep the premises clean and hygiene.
- The timely disbursal of scholarship to students is depended on the disbursals done by scholarship granting agencies. And college only looks after distributing received scholarship amount to beneficiary students. Actions are taken to speed up the distribution process without delay.


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Action Taken Report 2019-20 and 2020-21

Based on the feedback collected from students on syllabus following actions were taken

- ✓ Out of the total responses on 'Is syllabus creating interest in you' and 'the link between chapters', majority have given good response. And only 3% respondents marked 'poor'. And 4% said that the expectations fulfilled by syllabus is poor. The institution made an effort to convey the same to BoS through their representations as the institution cannot take any measure itself with regard syllabus rearrangement as it is framed by the University of Mysore.
- ✓ Around 4% of students responded poor about availability of reference books. The institution has taken steps to increase the number of reference books in the college library. In the tenure of three years (from 2018-19 to 2020-21) 945 books have been procured with a cost of Rs. 2,21,865.

Based on feedback from students on faculties, following actions were taken


- ✓ Teachers were instructed to be more available and accessible to students outside the class to clear their doubts.
- ✓ Teachers were encouraged to use ICT tools to make teaching learning experience effective.
- ✓ Mentoring system was strengthened to guide and counsel needy students.
- ✓ E-content to be developed and given to the students by the faculty.
- ✓ Experiential learning tools to be used were advised to the faculty.
- ✓ Personally, the feedback was shared with the faculty members on one-to-one basis and the SWOT of every employee was discussed.

**Based on feedback from faculty members on curriculum/ Infrastructure/ Governance/
IQAC**

- ✓ 90% of the faculties agree that the resources available in the college are student cantered. Actions are taken to make it 100% by increasing the number of books in the library, strengthening ICT infrastructure facilities, assisting students on online fee payment by faculties etc.
- ✓ The institution is successful in availing Government grants to build new building and thereby increasing the number of classrooms, labs, reading rooms and auditorium.
- ✓ Drinking water facility is improved by installing new water RO purifier. A separate rest room for students is constructed and efforts are made to increase the number of toilets and hygiene.
- ✓ Steps are taken to increase the availability of sports equipment.

Based on the feedback collected from alumni

- ✓ The analysis reveal that the alumni are satisfied with overall aspects of institution and development activities undertaken by the institution. And all respondents opined that they would recommend the institution amongst their family and friends' circle. However, the majority of the sample responded average score about college's infrastructure facilities. In this regard, the head of the college and CDC have taken measures to build new building to increase number of classrooms, laboratories, with ICT tools, and install drinking water purifier.
- ✓ Measures are taken to strengthen teacher-student relationship by augmenting alumni association activities and communication between college and alumni.
- ✓ The institution is planning on the programs to bridge the gap between industry and academics, career counselling and increase job opportunities through placement cell.


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
