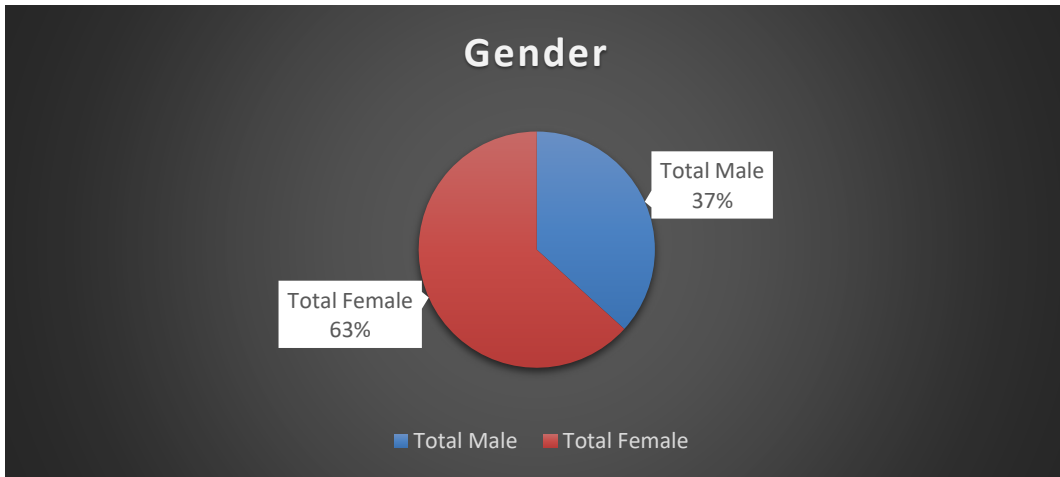

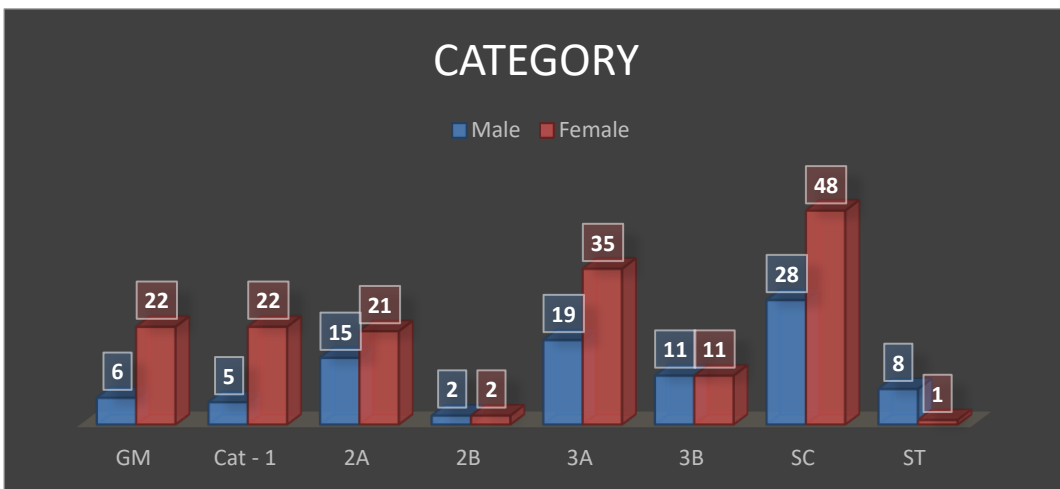

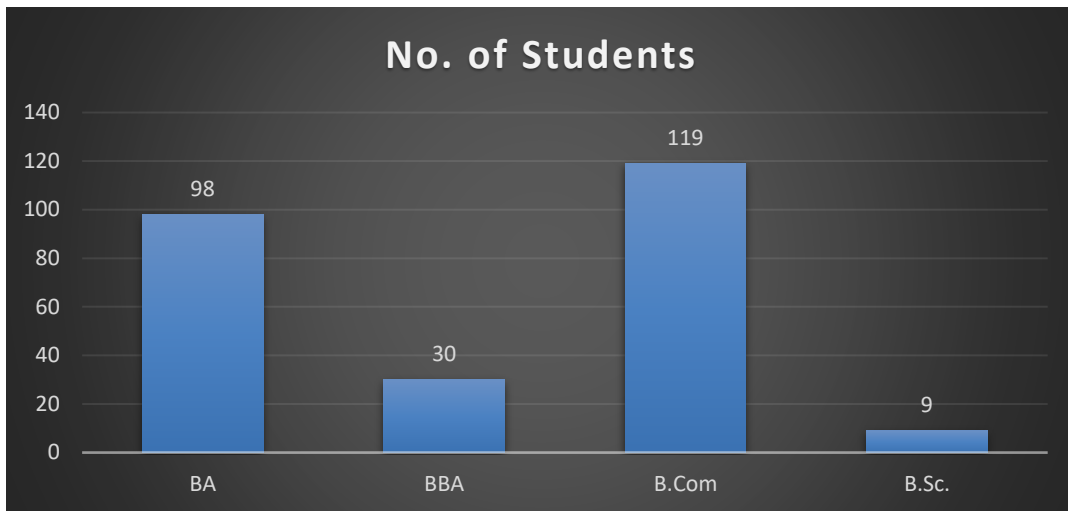
Student Self Survey Report

The above histogram reveals the category wise distribution of the student strength (both male & female).



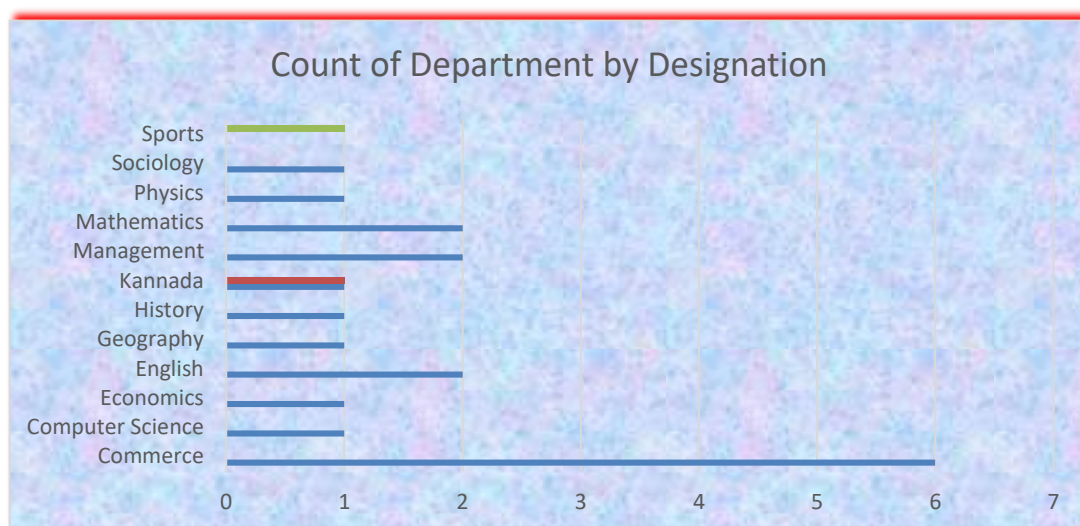

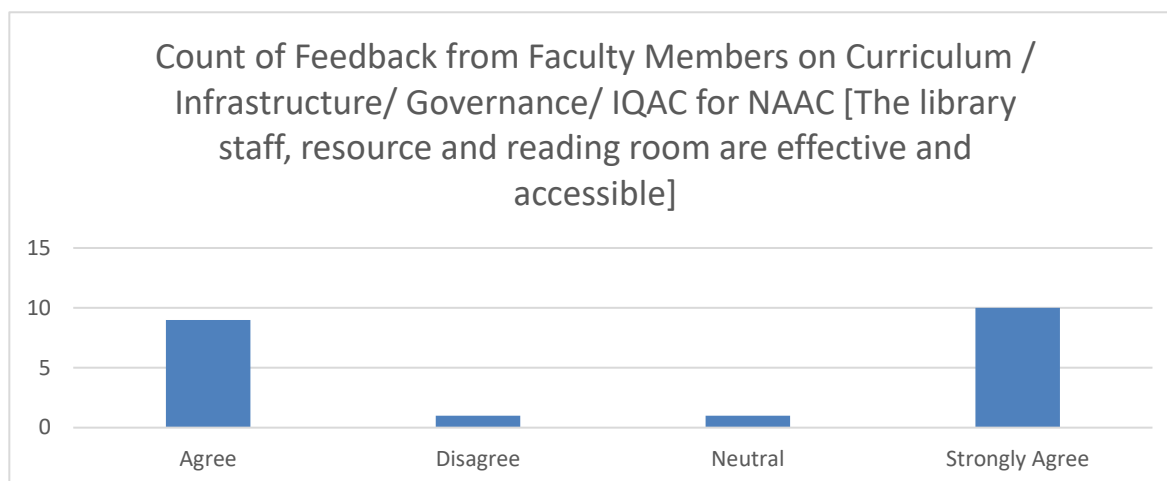
The above graph indicates the admission strength during past three years. It reveals that, the strength of the college is progressively increasing.

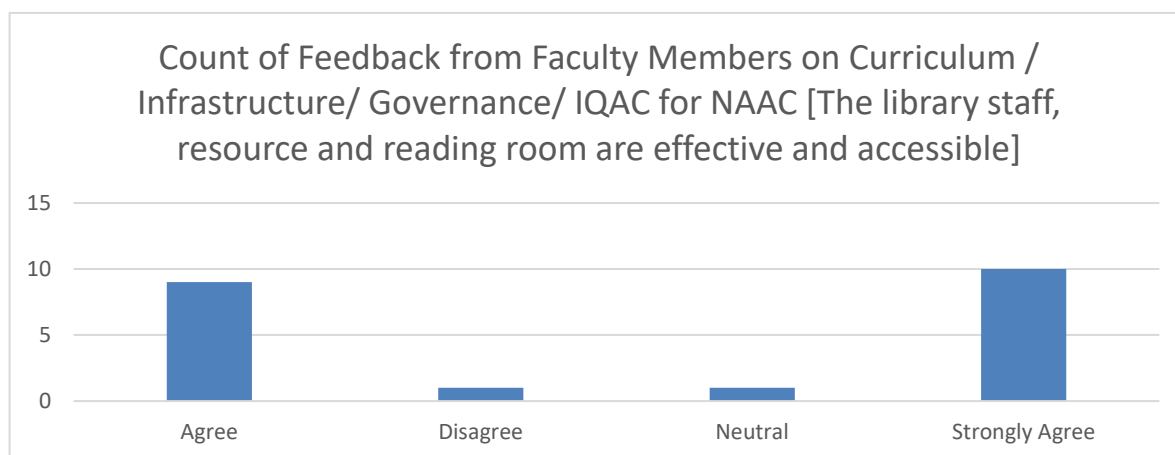


The line graph indicates the strength of the faculty members belonging to various departments. It clearly shows that highest faculty members are there for commerce department.



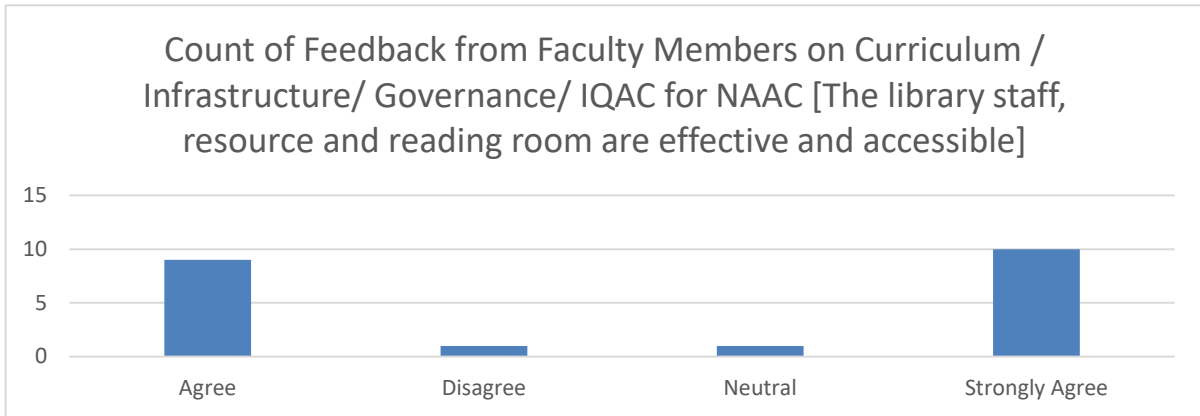
Regarding updation of syllabus and course details by the BOS of the concerned university faculty feedback.

The graphical analysis says faculty members strongly agreed for the relevance of the syllabus and course details.



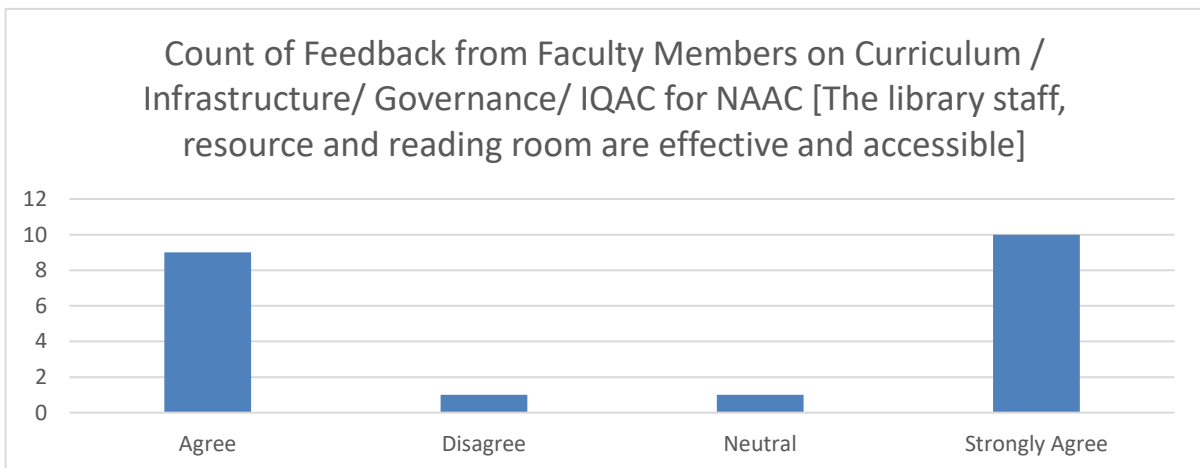
Regarding the objectives and outcomes of the syllabus.

The graphical representation shows that the objectives and outcomes of the course and syllabus are clearly defined.



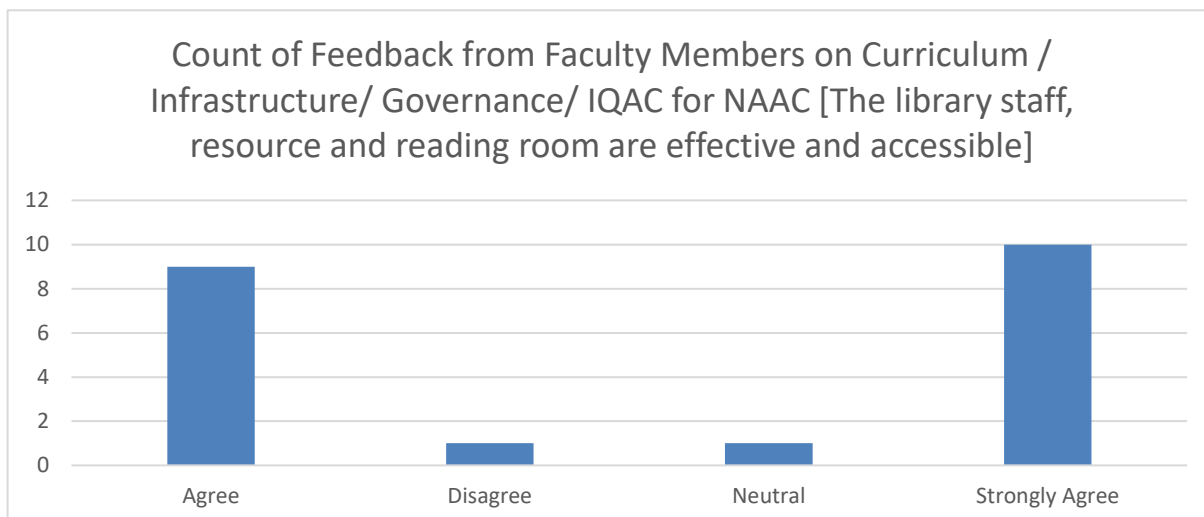
Prior preparation on concepts to be taught in the class.

The pictorial representation shows that faculty members strongly agree for the fact that before going to the classes prior preparation and good research is done on the relevant topics.



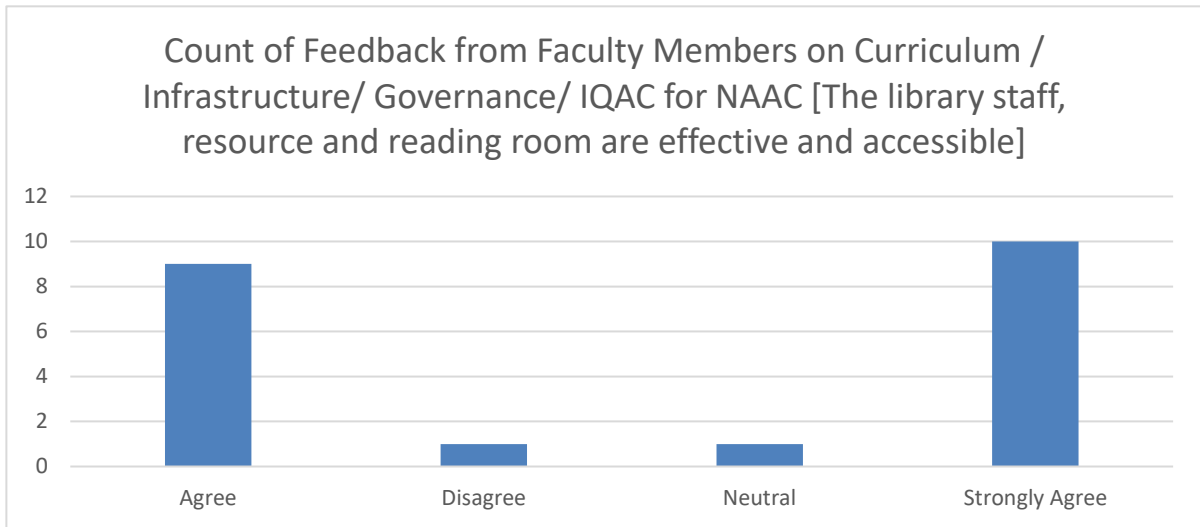
Availability

Student controlled learning resources the graph indicates that most of the faculty members believe that the resource available at the college are very much student centric.



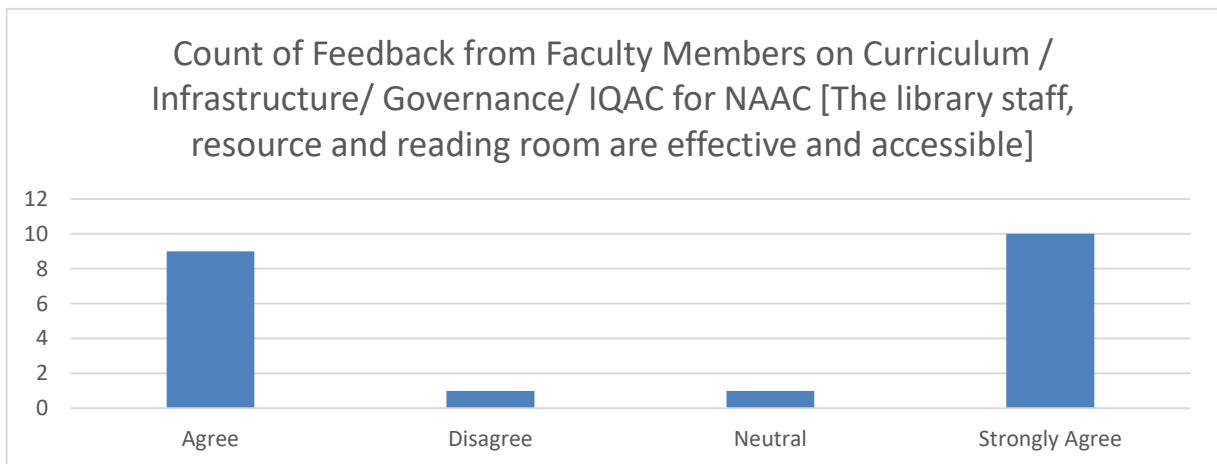
College calendar of events is very much synchronized with university calendar of events.

The graph indicates that the faculty members strongly believe that the calendar of events of the college goes well in accordance with university calendar of events.



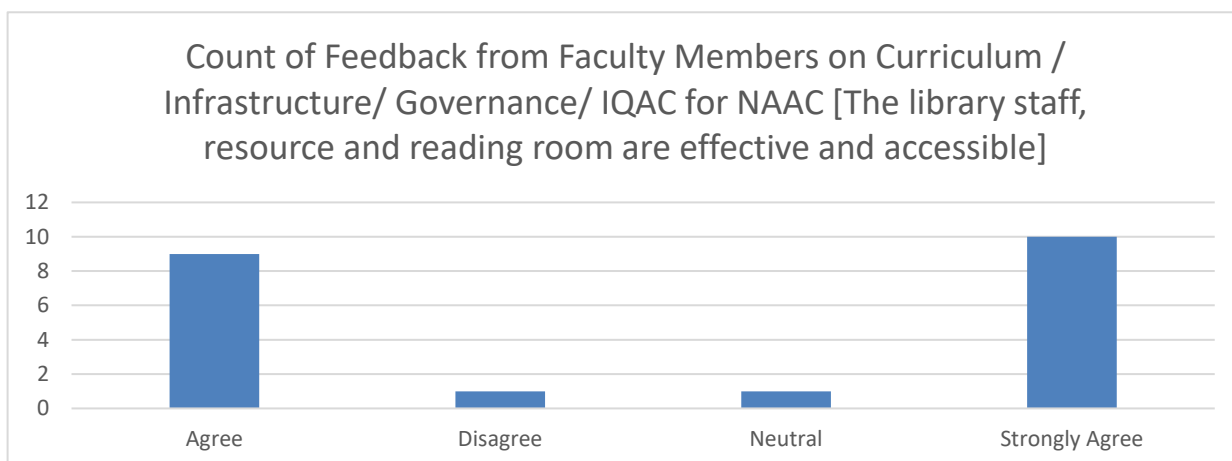
The library staff resource and reading room facilities are effective and accessible.

The graph reveals that the library facilities, such as books, magazines and reading room facilities are adequate for the faculty members and students.

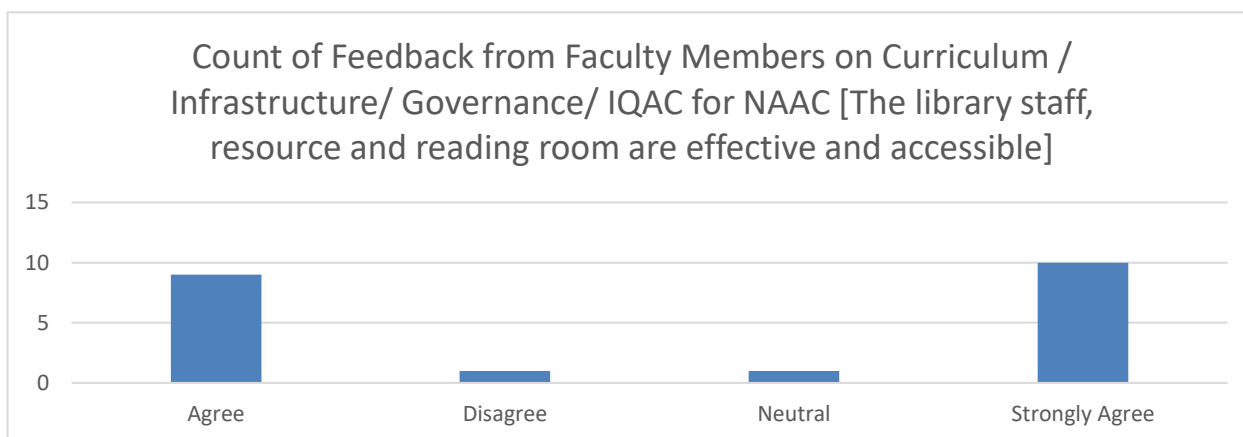


Classroom labs and furniture facilities are well maintained.

The histogram regarding the above said criteria shows that faculty members agree on the fact that laboratories, furniture and other physical resources are to be maintained adequately.

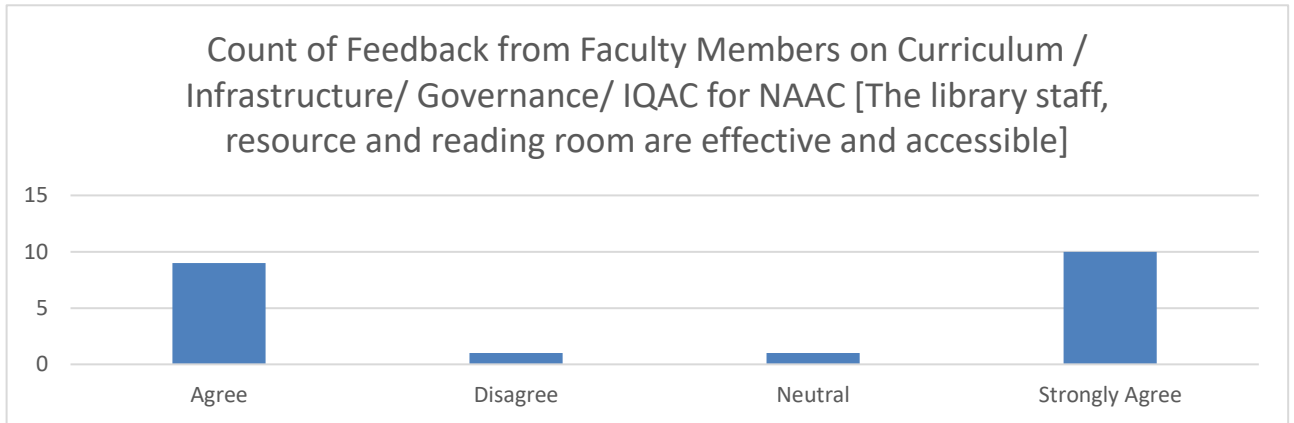

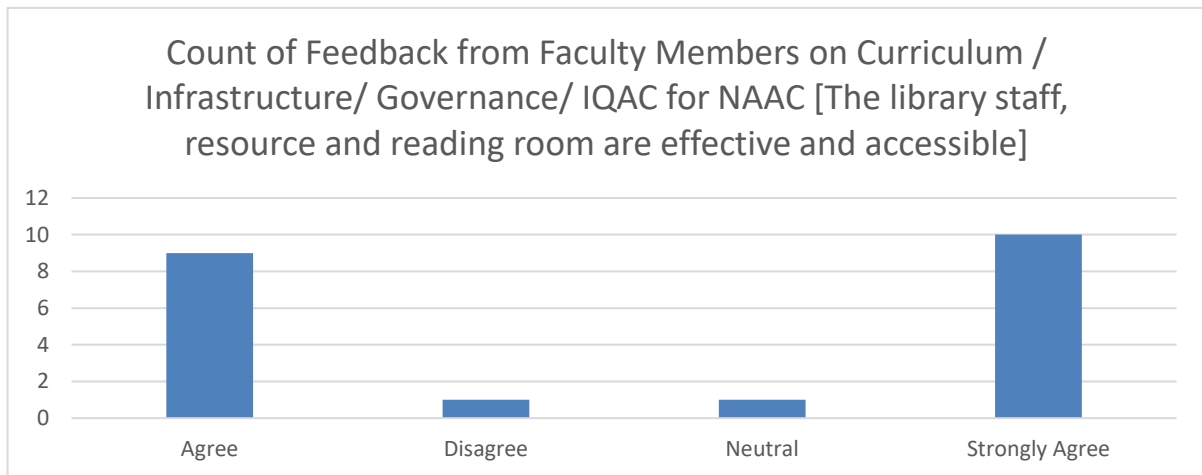


Encouragement for teachers to organize/participate in workshops/conferences.

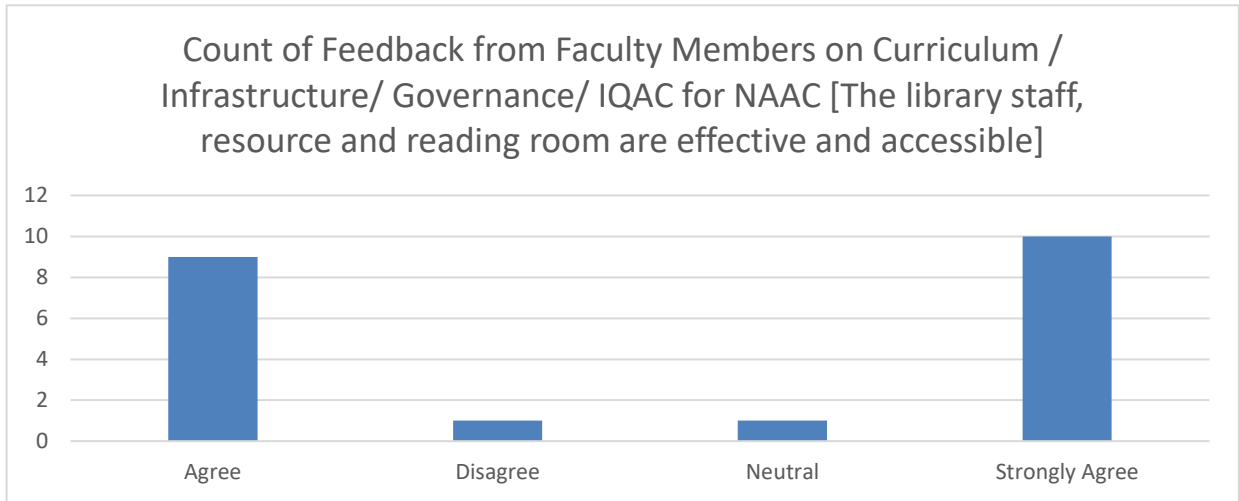
Most of faculty members opinated on the fact that they are encourage to organize/participate in workshops and conferences. It is revealed from the graph.



On the sports infrastructure most of the faculty members have opinion that sports infrastructures and sports staff are effective that is revealed from the graph.

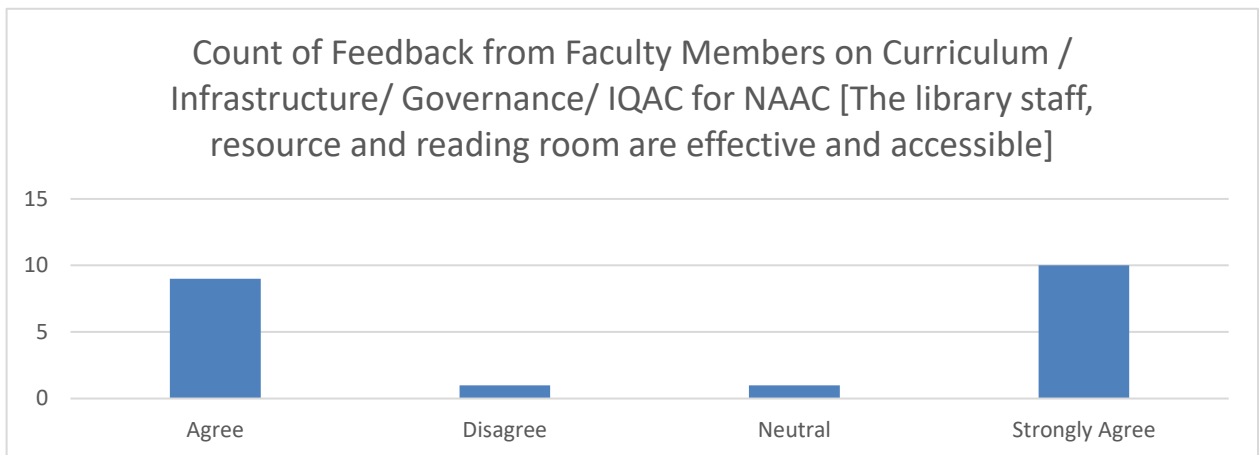


The sincerity of the administration towards the development of the institution. The graph shows that the staff members strongly believe that the administration of the college work for betterment of the institution.



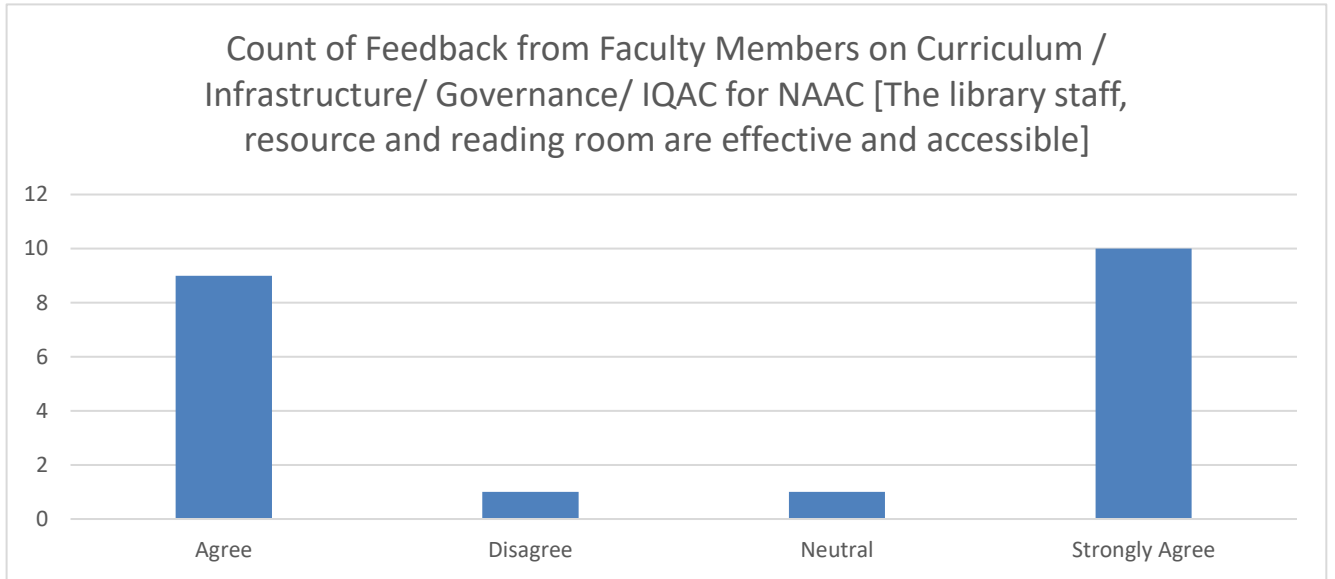
Quality of IQAC at our college level.

The graph depicts that the IQAC team of our college is putting sincere efforts for the good quality of higher education.

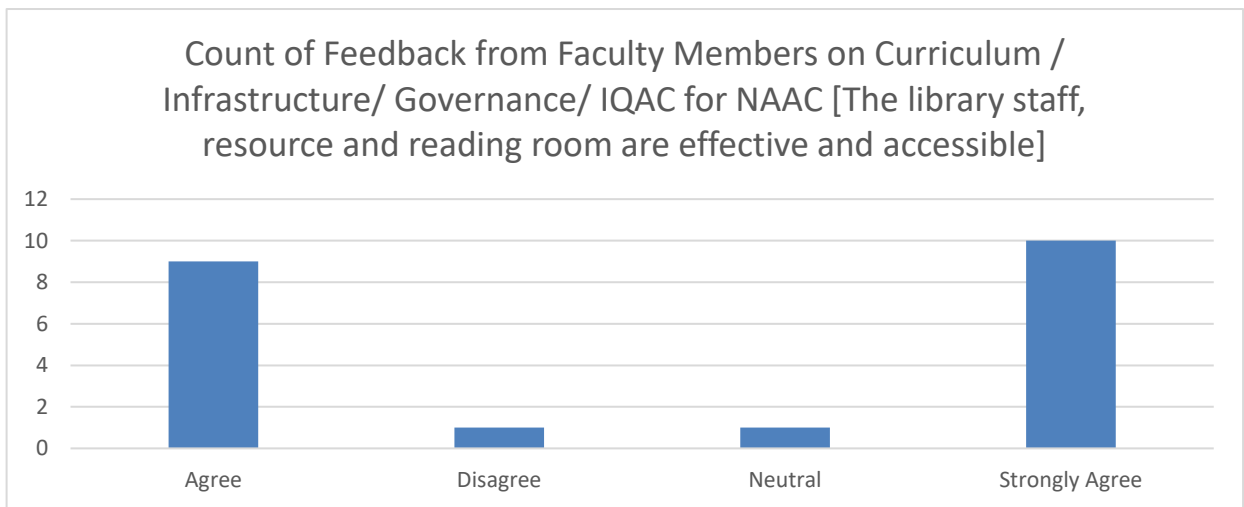


Support towards the on-line classes.

Support by IQAC towards the development of college.

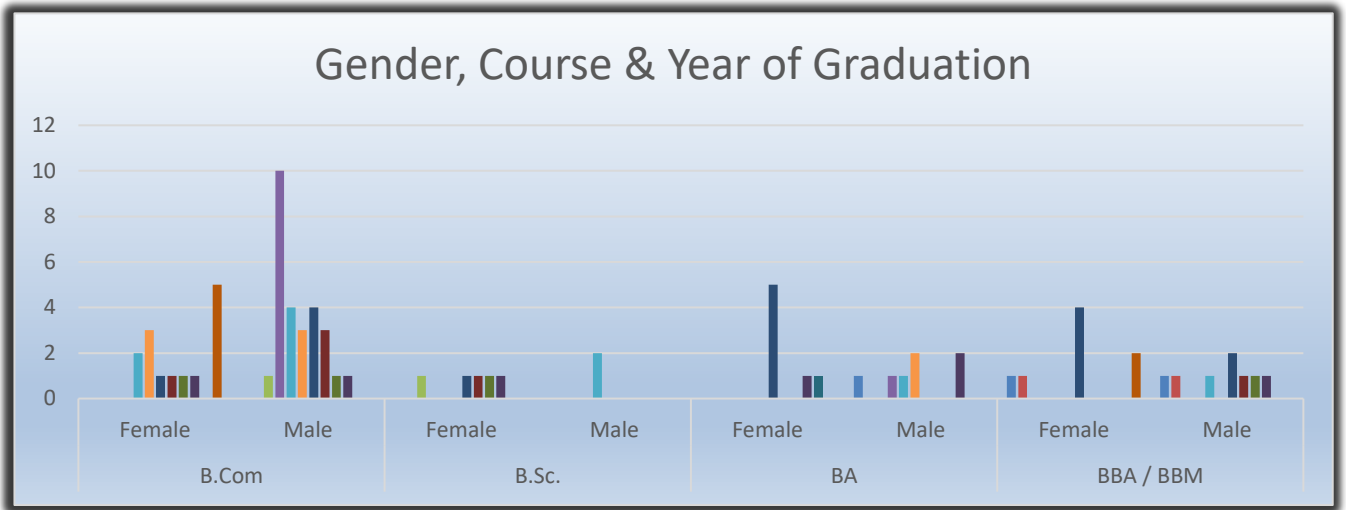

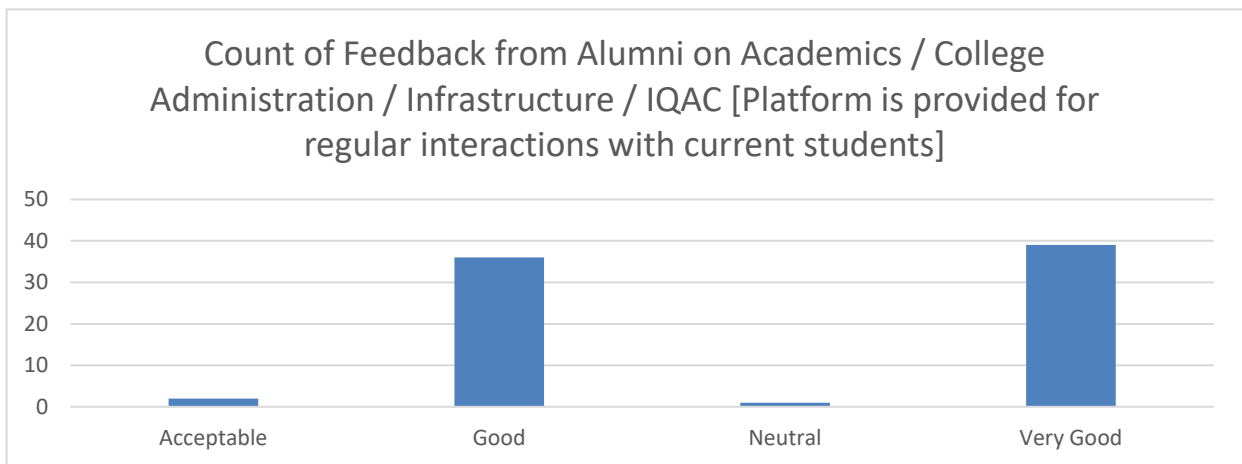

The histogram denotes the gender wise, course wise and year wise (year of graduation) alumni students feedback report.



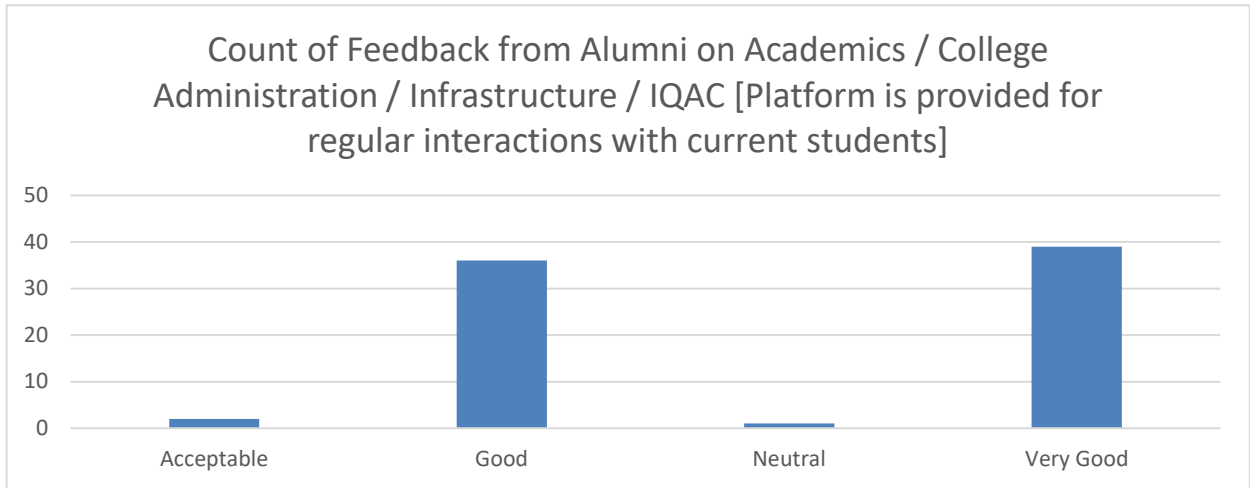
Alumni Association

The above graph shows that they strongly agree on the fact that alumni association has a good network of old friends.



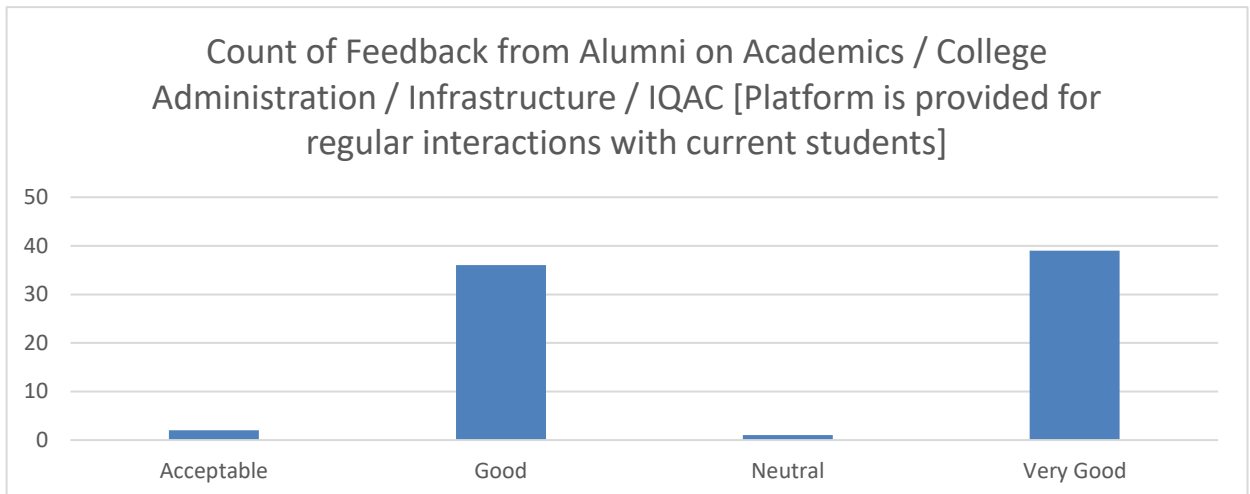
The easy accessibility of the principal

The old students opined that the head of the institution is easily accessible.



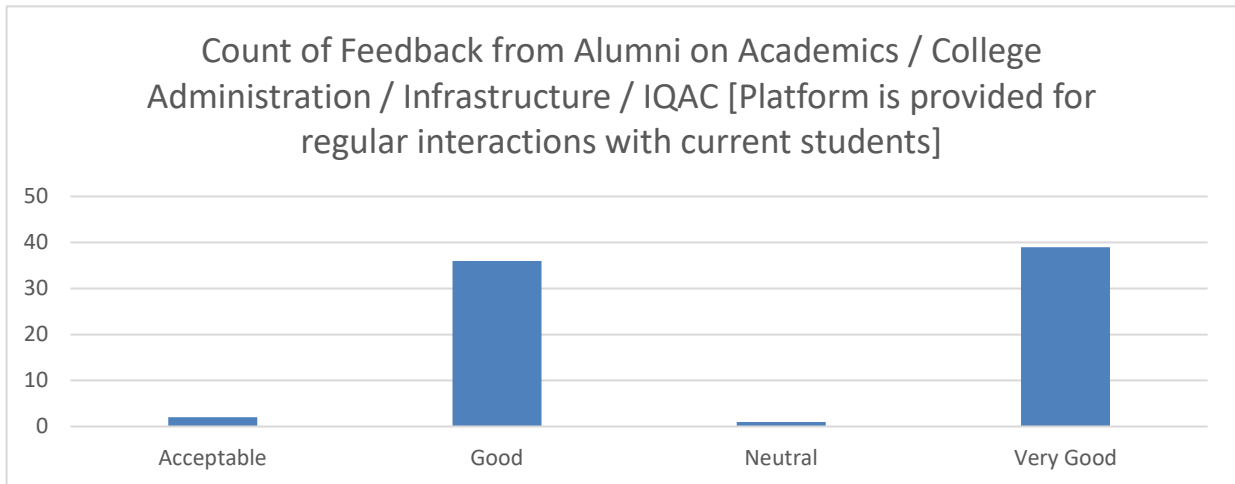
Administration staff are active and co-operative

Alumni opined that the administrative staff is highly co-operative and easily accessible.



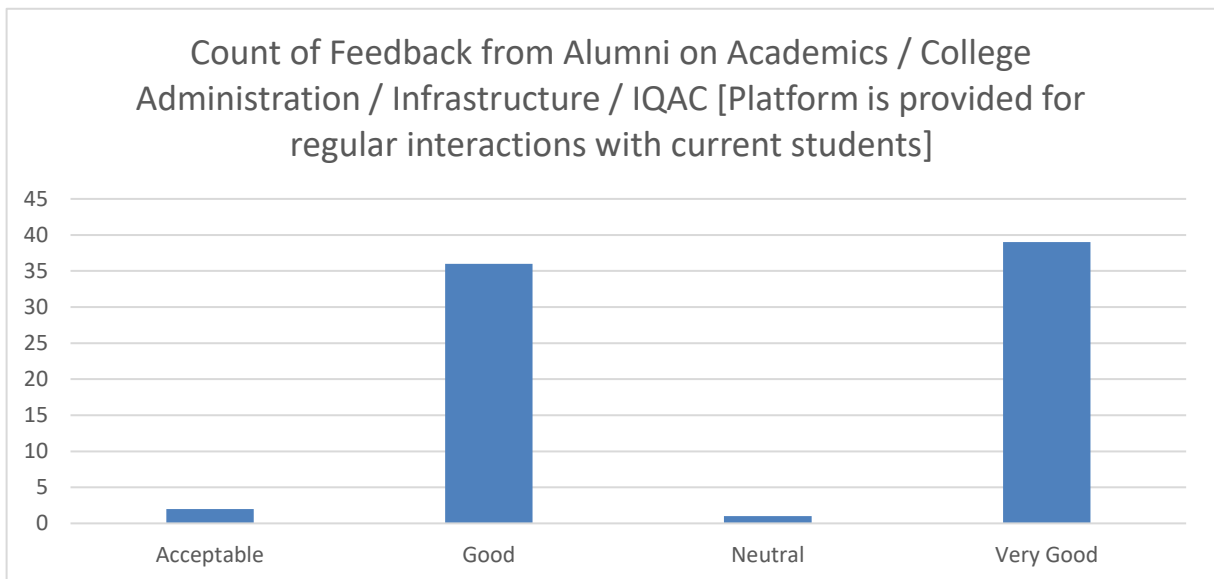
Reach ability of faculty members

Graph shows that alumni is very much in favour of the fact that the staff members inspite of their busy schedule they are easily accessible.



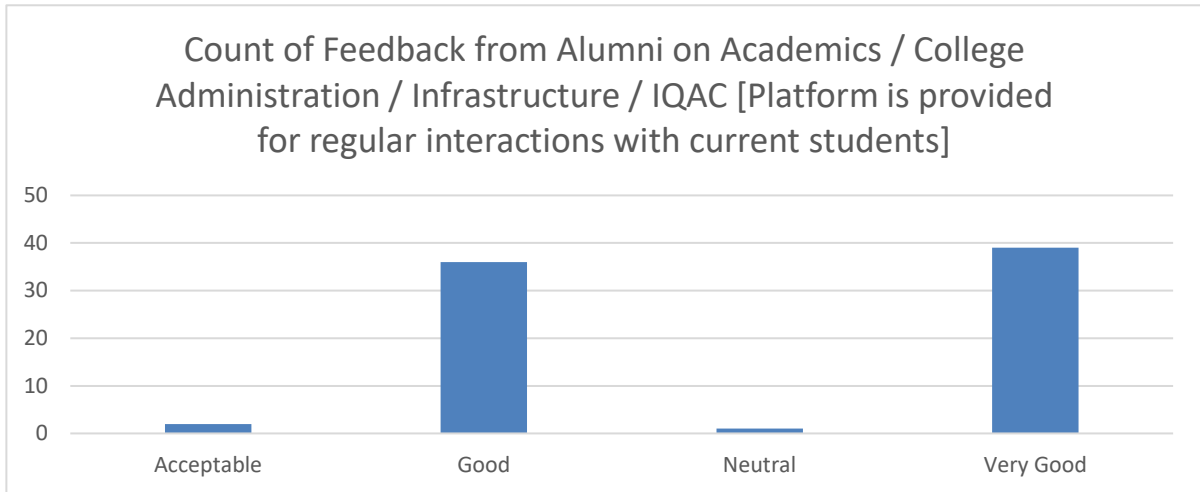

The bar graph indicates that the old students association strongly feels that their suggestions are positively valued.



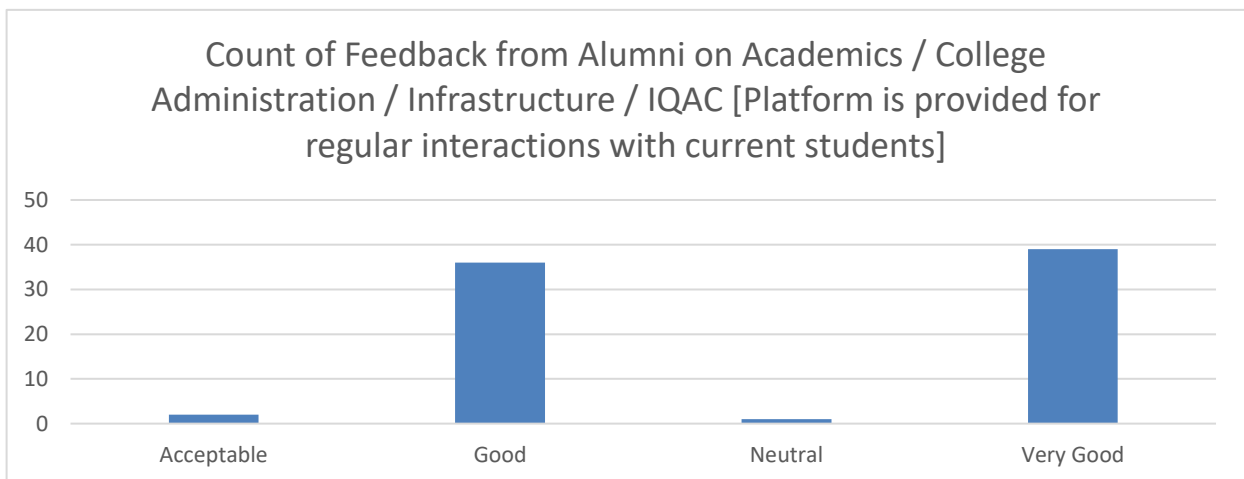
Interaction of alumni is with present batch.

The graph shows that alumni's are called to have an interaction with present batch of students regularly.



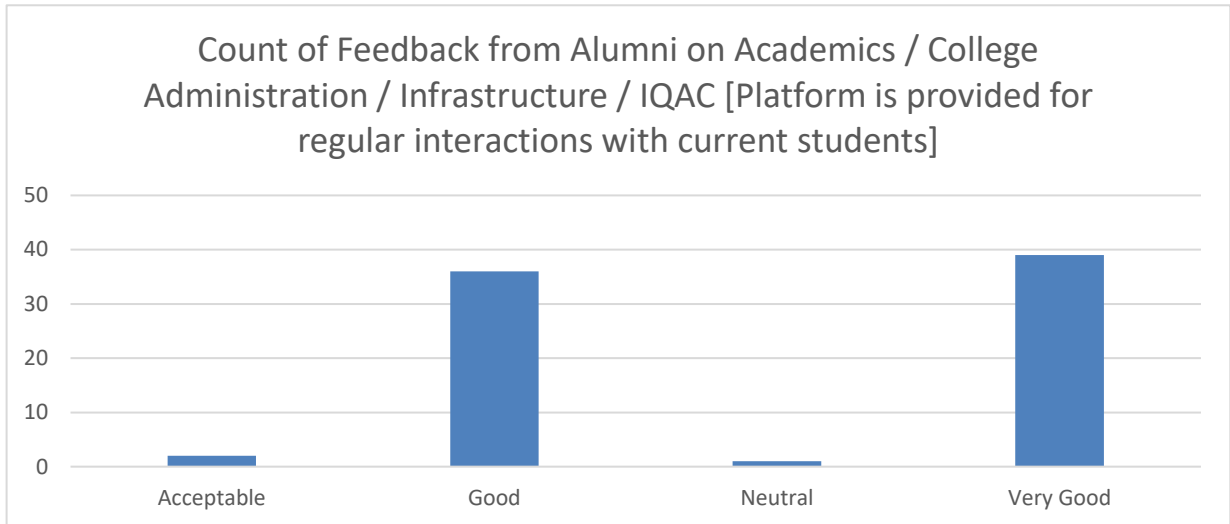
Registration of college alumni association

The bar graph says that the college alumni association is registered and takes active part for the development of the institution.



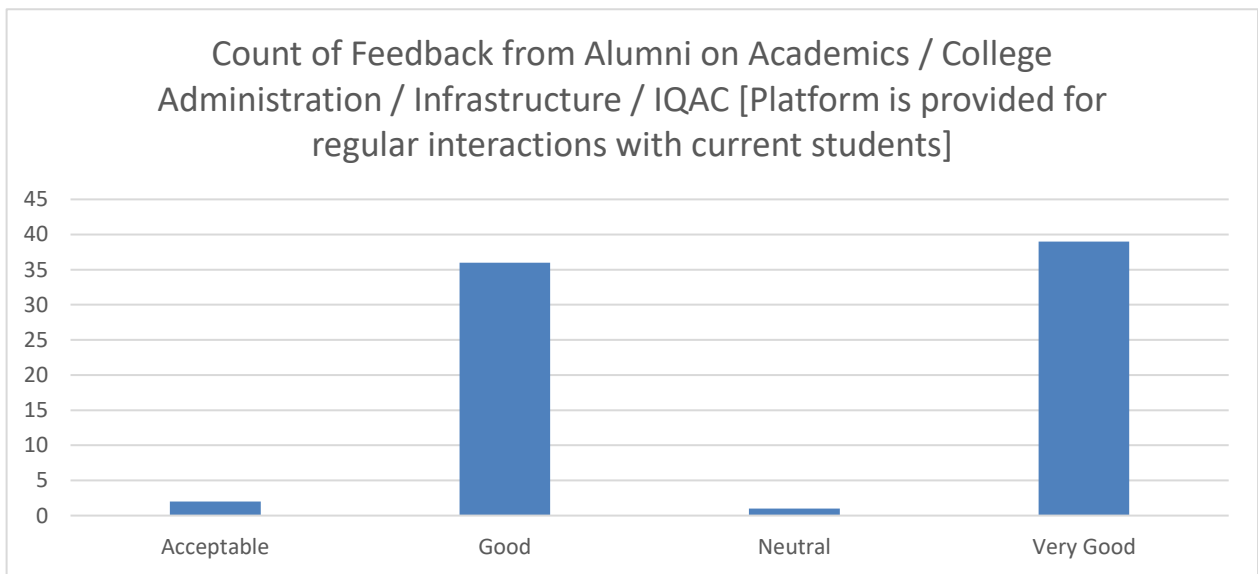

The bar graph denotes that employability of course is very good.



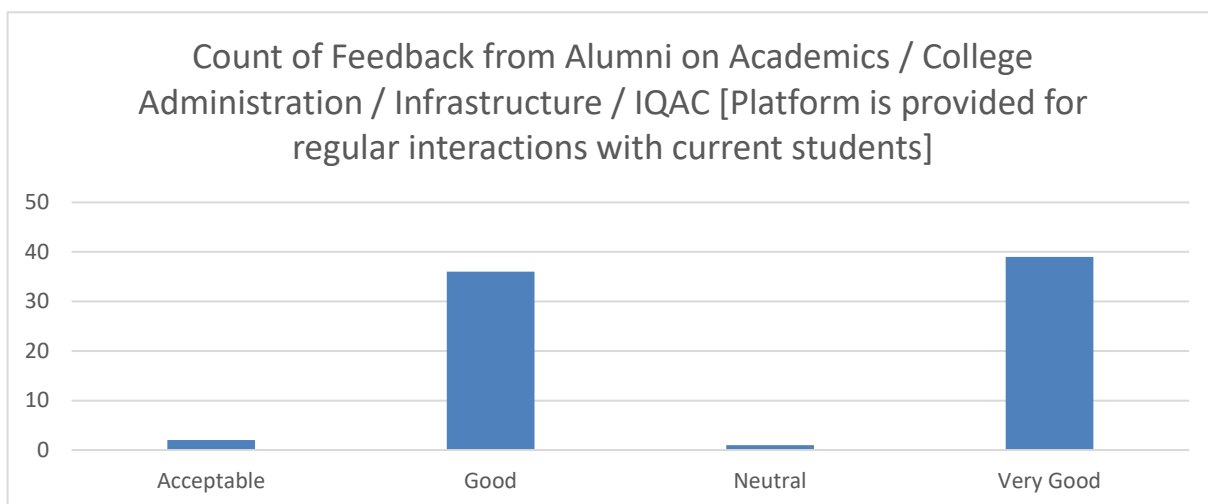
Rating of alumni with reference to teaching/learning and administration.
