CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS**

The goal of an educational institution is to make its students disciplined, skilled with societal and environmental commitment, knowledgeable, and responsible citizens. To accomplish this, it has formulated a code of conduct that will guide them.

All students who are admitted to the Government First Grade College in Kengeri follow the guidelines established by the institution.

**Code of conduct for the students:**

1. Shall maintain the highest degree of discipline inside and outside the premises of the campus.
2. The students are expected to follow the rules and regulations of the school in order to maintain the high standards of the institution.
3. Shall be very punctual, obedient to the classes and for the professors and should have to strictly follow the timetable derived by the institute.
4. Should have to reach a minimum of 75% of attendance in order to appear for the university examinations
5. Shall attend all courses classes without any kind of misbehavior and maintain classroom discipline without engaging in actions that compromise the classroom's integrity.
6. Should not enter or leave the classroom without the prior permission of the professor in the class.
7. Except Wednesday, every student of the college should have to wear the uniform which is prescribed by the college.
8. Should have to wear the college identity cards on all the days which is provided by the college, students are not permitted to enter the institute premises without a valid identity cards
9. Strictly should not to bear the time in the college after the classes
10. Should have to bear their free time in the college library



11. Should not loiter/whistle/scream/talk in the corridor which may attract punishment from disciplinary committee.
12. Should not use alcohol/intoxicants/drugs, which are punishable by harsh penalty and suspension It is highly forbidden to consume alcohol, take drugs, or smoke. Students who engage in such illicit acts will face harsh penalties.
13. Most importantly, the co-students of the institute should not discriminate individuals based on caste, creed, community, gender, color, language, marital status, physical or mental disability.
14. Should not involve in anti-social activities
15. Should not use mobile phones as the usage of mobile phones is strictly prohibited inside the institution
16. Must not taunt, use abusive language, or touch female students, and if this occurs, will be submitted to the anti-sexual harassment cell, and the punishment imposed will be final. The Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell was established in accordance with UGC guidelines for the prevention, prohibition, and redressal of sexual harassment of female staff and students in higher education institutions (UGC Regulations 2015).
17. Will not engage in ragging. The anti-ragging cell has been formed and is operational. Ragging is a crime that will result in severe punishment. Students who engage in ragging will be expelled from college, and a FIR will be filed.
18. Should not be in the possession of arms, ammunition, explosives, potential weapons contrary to law.
19. Should not be in contact or member of any terrorist group or underworld group.
20. Should not fight with other students and shall not manhandle/injure/abuse other students, which will result in penalty and punishment. It will be brought to the Discipline Committee's attention, and the penalty or punishment will be imposed based on the committee's decision, which will be led by the Principal
21. Strictly adhered to follow that do not destroy the college property. If done so, the student responsible has to replace or bear the cost of the repair.
22. Should respect the Principal, Teaching, non-teaching staff and the fellow students
23. Should not manhandle/cause physical injuries to other students or staff which invites strict legal punishment
24. Should make use of all the facilities optimally
25. Must actively participate in Institutional Social Responsibility by joining the NCC, NSS, YRC, Rangers, and Rovers
26. Will not commit any irregularities (copying, malpractice) during Internal Assessment tests or Bangalore University Examinations If found guilty, you will be forbidden from taking exams at BU, according to BU policy.
27. Should take part in curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities
28. Should not use plastics unnecessarily on the campus and shall not use the plastic files for submitting assignments.
29. Should maintain the campus green and clean.
30. Should follow UGC, DCE and Bangalore University guidelines.
