### **STRENGTH**

- The college has the necessary infrastructure required to accommodate the growing number of students.
- The institution has 2(f) and 12(B) status
- The institution offers undergraduate and postgraduate Degree Courses in Arts, Science, Commerce & Management and Computer Science Applications.
- Most of the faculty members are BOS and BOE committee Chairpersons & members
- Teachers are actively involved in research activities, more than 100 research papers have been published in reputed peer reviewed national and international journals. There are five research guides.
