2. **Objectives of the Practice:** Improve innovative thinking ability of the students.
3. **The Context:** To prepare the Final year BBA/B.Com students for higher studies and improve their innovative thinking ability.
4. **The Practice:** Final B.Com/BBA students were divided in to groups/teams and each team was assigned with the task of developing a new product (altogether new product), produce a working model of it and present it to the class.
5. **Evidence of Success:** Students showed a lot of enthusiasm in the concept. All teams prepared new products. Some teams have come out with altogether new products like mixer grinder with remote, Automated decorative fountain etc. Some of them had even consulted their counterparts in science branch, engineers and technicians to get the practicability and technical knowledge.
6. **Problems Encountered and Resources Required:** The process requires the students to

incur expenditure, which the department/college couldn't provide. Though the students could plan some newer products, their prototype production requires them to spend some amount which is limited in the hands of the students of our college. Entire project was done through self financing by the students. Poor financial back ground of the students prevented them from going for higher level of innovative products requiring huge expenditure.
