The institution has arranged special lectures from experts and environmentalists to make the students environment conscious “Ozone Depletion,” “Global warming” “Co-existing with animal” , and “Plant Kingdom” etc. were some of the topics covered by them. It could help to inculcate awareness among the students about global environmental issues and concerns. The students realize that men should progress with nature and not against nature.
- n) Our campus is a plastic free and parthenium free zone, students of each class weed out parthenium time and again. We sort out wastes in three parts. Non-biodegradable, E-waste and Bio-degradable waste which is dumped separately and dispose all the three according to the norms prescribed by the concerned health departments and civic bodies. Students themselves prepare thought provoking and awareness articles and publish them in wall magazines of different departments. They focus on how to maintain eco-friendly environment having all its flora and fauna.
