

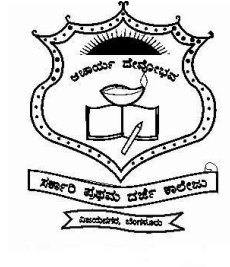

PART-A

The plan of action prepared by the IQAC to improve the quality and the outcome:

This was a significant year for us as the College was due for reaccreditation by NAAC and for the celebration of its Silver Jubilee. Hence, we had to chalk-out programmes, activities and a plan of action to execute them.

1. Getting the college reaccredited with better grade by NAAC was our first priority

- Dr. Sharada Jayagovind as Coordinator with the help of the committee members Prof. Doreen Snehalatha Kotian and Dr. Bhanumathi Haran and also with the active support of teachers, office staff and students did a commendable job in getting the reaccreditation process by NAAC's Peer team members completed. We are happy to report that our college got **"B" grade**. Happily, we have improved our grade from the previous C++.

2. Organizing Silver Jubilee function of the College

- A Committee was constituted by local MLA and Chairman of the College Development Council Shree.M.Krishnappa to steer the activities. Many activities have been initiated for this purpose.

3. Implementing the suggestions made by NAAC 's Peer Team

- Administrative actions have been initiated in this regard.

4. The college had planned to expand its physical infrastructure:

- The third floor of the college building is completed and it is ready for use.

5. Improving Library Service:

- Books worth Rs.1,50,000 (from UGC fund) were procured to equip the Kannada library as Kannada MA classes have begun.

6. To improve the infrastructure of laboratories

7. To improve the quality of student performance:

- Bridge and remedial courses were conducted with the help of grants released by UGC. Teachers also adopted a few innovative methods of teaching. Dictation of notes is stopped, instead students are asked to prepare notes
- Dhyana and Yoga therapies are adopted to improve the concentration of students

- A number of seminars and lectures were held to upgrade the knowledge and skill of the students and teachers.

8. To introduce innovative methods of teaching

- Innovative methods of teaching and learning, like group discussions, industrial visits, role play and use of music and dance to teach literary texts were adopted.
- Dr. N.R.Lalithamba, Professor of Kannada has successfully used dance, songs, mime to teach Kannada poetry.

9. To upgrade the knowledge of computer use among teaching and non teaching staff

- Teaching sessions in computer basics were conducted to faculty members of the college by the staff members of the department of Computer Science.

10.Planned to approach UGC for financial assistance to organize seminars, to conduct workshops, and take up minor projects

- Our efforts have yielded excellent results as UGC has sanctioned grants to all our projects. Details of the programmes and grants allocated by UGC are as follows.

- UGC has sanctioned to the department of Economics Rs 60,000 to organize a National seminar; Rs 1,00,000 to organize a National seminar on human rights; Rs75, 000 to organize a symposium and Rs 1,00,000 to organize a workshop.

11. Setting up of NCC unit.

- This is one of our long cherished aspirations and it is a reality now. A unit has started functioning from this academic year
- Additional block of class rooms was added to meet the needs of increasing number of students.

12. Procured more books and journals to the library.

13. Provided Xerox facility in the library and computerization process is going on.

14. Strengthened the Tutor Ward system, which facilitates counseling and monitoring of student development.

15. Improved the quality of the college magazine 'Vijaya Vidyarthi' by introducing new items like space for alumni, and an art section.

16. A number of cultural activities like debate, quiz, singing and dancing competitions etc. were conducted.

17. Theatre club has been strengthened by Dr. Ramesh Chandra Duth, who is a well known theatre personality and also Professor of Kannada in our College. The club successfully staged plays in our college and also at city theatres for the general public.

18. Conducted a number of community service activities like blood donation camps, free medical checkup etc. through NSS.

PART-B

(1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:

- In the year 2008-09 many activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution were conducted.
- Our objective of the institution is to provide quality education to the youth by focusing on their physical, intellectual, scientific, social and spiritual development. Many activities were held to promote these qualities in our students.
- An orientation programme for the first year students was conducted on the reopening day. This programme is aimed to help freshers to familiarize with the college, teachers, infrastructure and also enable them understand their roles and responsibilities.

- National festivals like Independence Day and Republic day were celebrated. Dr. Suprabha HOD of History addressed the students and she reminded them their role in safeguarding sovereignty of our land. Dr. N.Nagaraju, Principal presided over the function.

Cultural Activities:

- On 5th September, 2008, teacher's day was celebrated.
- Swami **"Vivekananda Day"** was celebrated on 22-01-2010. Dr.M.K.Srikantaiah, Professor of Sociology and Dr.Sharadajayagovind, Professor of English spoke on the life and teachings of Swami Vivekananda.
- 500th year of the coronation ceremony of Krishnadevaraya the mighty and the benevolent emperor of Vijayanagar Empire was celebrated on 22nd January 2010. Several cultural programmes and competitions were conducted to mark the occasion. College cultural troupes presented "Dollu Kunitha" a dance-percussion programme at Hampi, the capital of Vijayanagar Empire on this occasion (29th January 2010).
- "TALENTS-2009-2010"- A five days 'cultural competitions' were conducted to identify and select best talented students. As many as 20 competitions were and over 500 students participated in it.
- 21 students of our College participated in various inter-collegiate cultural competitions organized by ISKCON, Bangalore in September 2009 and won 2 first, 2 special satisfactory and 7 satisfactory prizes. Besides, our College was adjudged 5th best College.
- Our students participated in the inter-collegiate cultural competitions organized by Bharatha Yathra Kendra, Bangalore, from 15th to 28th October 2009 and won many prizes.
- Our students have won prizes at "Gayana Sambhrama" competitions organized by GFC on 28th October 2009 and also in a similar competitions organized by "Rangotri" from 18th to 28th October 2009.
- Our students presented a ballet choreographed by Dr. L.G.Meera in an inter-collegiate ballet competition organized by GSC, Bangalore on 4th March 2010 and won third prize along with a cash prize of Rs 2000.

Rangachiranthana: The College theatre club:

- Our college has a theatre club set up by Dr. Ramesh Chandra Duth, Professor of Kannada. With the help of Dr.L.G.Meera and Dr.Lalithamba, he directed and conducted a one month long workshop from 18-9-2009 to train students in various aspects of theatre such as acting, dancing, singing, lighting etc.

- The college troupe participated in the theatre competition organized by Bharatha Yathra Kendra and staged a play written by Thejasvi. One of our students won 'Best Actor' Prize.
- Our students staged the play "Rahasya Visva" in the theatre competitions organized by 'Rangotri" and won trophies and fourth prize. This play saw its third show at "Freedom Park" , Bangalore
- Women cell, placement cell, Counseling Cell, N.S.S, Sports department conduct several activities through out the year to promote physical and emotional health of the students and staff.

Press Club:

Harsha Kumar.H.S, Assistant Professor of Journalism has formed press club to create a forum for the students of journalism. The club has organized many programmes and activities during this year.

- Organized a special lecture on 'Recent Trends in Journalism' in our college on 7th Sept 2010. Prof. Padmanabha delivered special lecture.
- Organized a documentary show on tribal life at our College on 22nd Sept 2010. EMRC of Mysore presented the programme.
- Our students participated in a programme organized by Media Photographers' Association on 18th Oct 2010

THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

Dr. R.Komala, Professor & HOD of the department of Economics with the active help of her colleagues has initiated many activities to develop the department and help students.

- Artha Manthana- Monthly in-house journal published.
- UGC sponsored 5 days' work shop on "Capacity Building of Women Managers in Higher Education" was organized between 18th and 22nd Aug 2009.
- Self financed symposium on "UNION BUDGET-2010-11" was organized on 10th March 2010.

- The Department has set up its library “Artha Bhandara” and has over 600 books fetched through donations.
- Professor B.B.Rajamma had organized a study trip to Ramanagaram Sericulture Market to enable students to understand the problems and prospects of sericulture.
- 2 seminars, 1 symposium, 7 day workshop-sanctioned by UGC.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH:

- Conducts ‘BRIDGE COURSE’ for freshers at the beginning of the year
- ‘Mind Management and Dhyana’ to achieve ‘2D’s-discovering and disciplining mind- is a unique approach introduced by Dr.Sharada Jayagovind and Dr.Bhanumathi Haran and enable students to overcome stress.
- Conducted spoken English classes for students.
- Introduced a new course in Communicative English from July 2010.
- Planning to organize a workshop to evolve a special method to teach English to Government College students.

WOMEN’S FORUM- Mahila Jagruthi Vedike :

- The College has taken measure to address gender related issues. We have a Women’s Forum. Dr. L.G.Mira, Professor of Kannada is its Convener. The Vedike had organized many programmes to enable both teachers and students to cultivate concern for gender sensitive issues. Programmes promoting gender equity and social justice were conducted. The five day UGC sponsored workshop on ‘Capacity Building of Women Managers in Higher Education’ was held from 18th August to 22nd August 2009. Our college is the first government college in Karnataka to organize such a workshop. Thirty five delegates from different colleges participated in the programme and received training. Eminent resource persons from different parts of the country provided instruction. This programme was organized by the Department of Economics.
- ‘**Eleyum, Mullum**’- a Malayalam documentary depicting eve-teasing as a social evil was screened on 27th October 2010. Samatha Mahila Vedike a women’s organization helped us to organize this programme.
- Smt Sumithra Acharya delivered two lectures on ‘laws regarding women and family’. This programme was sponsored by the State’s Women’s Commission.
- International Women’s Day was celebrated on 8th March 2010. Interactive programme “My Experience as a Working Woman” was organized involving women employees of the college to mark the occasion.
- The Forum is quite active and addresses the problems of both students and women staff as and when the need arises.

DEPARTMENT OF KANNADA:

- With the collaboration of Kannada Development Authority, Government of Karnataka, a “Kannada Awareness” programme was organized on 27th July 2010 to sensitize students understand the problems impeding the development of the language and the Kannadigas living in the border area. Shree Chandru, Chairperson of KDA, Dr. K.R.Sandhya Reddy spoke on the Occasion. Dr. Bananduru Kempaiah entertained the audience with folk songs.
- A unique programme “Kuvempu Bhavayana” exhibiting a rich collection of photos on the life and works of the national poet K.V.Puttappa was organized on 29th March and on 1st April 2010. Shree M.Varadaraju, Professor of Kannada, GMC Mandya spoke on Kuvempu’s works on this occasion. This programme attracted public also.
- A ‘Bridge-Course’(Sethu Bandha) was conducted covering various aspects of Kannada literature for the benefit of students studying Kannada as an optional subject.
- Shree M.S.Murthy, a well known artist delivered a very useful lecture on the importance of lines in pictures on 10th Oct 2010. Incidentally our students have this topic as a lesson.
- Well known story writer shree Vasudhendra delivered a special lecture on the topic ‘story as a form of literature’.
- A special programme on “Kannada and Computer Network’, E-learning and its technical aspects was organized on 1st, 5th and 8th April for the benefit of commerce students.

DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE:

- Dr. Ravindra, Professor of Computer Science, Karnataka University Dharwad, delivered lecture on “DBMS Concepts” to our students on 12th Sept 2010
- The Department had organized a programme to educate our students on importance and methods of disposing ‘E-waste’ on 13th October 2010.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY:

- The Department had organized a lecture on “The problems and prospects of women’s education”. S.Kanakalakshmi, Professor of Sociology, GFC, Bangalore delivered the lecture.

Post Graduate Course:

- The Post-graduate Course in Kannada was started from this academic year 2009-10. The college has qualified teachers, adequate books and infrastructure to offer the PG course.

(3) Innovation in curricular design and transaction:

- Some of our staff members have contributed to curricular design and transaction in their capacity as members of BOS and BOE of Bangalore University and other autonomous colleges.
- Dr. M.K.Srikantaiah, Professor of Sociology has served as Member BOS, BOE and Faculty of Arts and also Chairperson BOE
- Dr. R. Komala Dept of Economics, has served as member of BOE, BU.
- Dr. Shobha Ramesh has served as member of BOE, BU.
- Dr.Sharada Jayagovind, Department of English, member BOS, Bangalore University 2008-11. Member of the General English text book committee for B.A/B.Sc/B.Com.
- Dr. Bhanumathi Haran, Department of English, member of General English text book committee, Bangalore University 2008-10.
- Dr. L.G.Meera, Professor of Kannada served as a member of Editorial Board of Kannada text book committee of Bangalore University In addition to all these cultural activities, a number of innovative practices were introduced in the academic life of the college. Films related to social issues were screened. Discussions were held with the directors and script writers and students wrote reviews on these films. The best film reviews were awarded prizes.
- Science departments have motivated the students to start wall magazines which provide information on the latest development in science and technology.

December 2009 respectively. One M.Phil student submitted her dissertation to M.K.U.

- Dr. Ramesh Chandra Duth: Professor of Kannada- One of his research students has been awarded Ph.D degree by the Bangalore University.

(4) Interdisciplinary Programmes:

The UGC sponsored Add on Course on Kindergarten Management started by the college is basically an interdisciplinary Course. Members from the departments of Sociology, Psychology, Kannada and English teach the course. Faculty members from Himanshu, Malleshwaram teach subjects related to child education.

(5) Examination reforms implemented:

- The college is affiliated to Bangalore University and follows the guidelines and regulations of the university.
- Several steps have been taken by the college to make the examination system transparent and student friendly.
- Internal assessment of the courses is done through unit tests, assignments and projects. Students are given the opportunity to improve their performance by repeat tests.
- Collection of exam fee, distribution of hall ticket and mark card is computerized and done efficiently through the help of office and teaching staff in the class rooms. Reformatations introduced by Bangalore University such as submission of OMR application forms, on-line submission of Internal assessment marks have been implemented.
- Internal assessment marks will be notified in advance to help students bring any anomaly in their marks to the notice of the concerned teachers and get it rectified before it is sent to the University.
