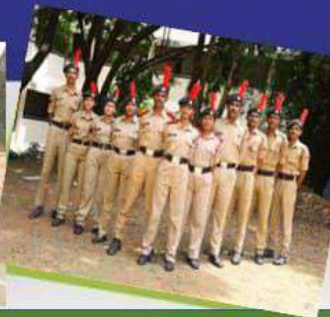

**ORIENTATION PROGRAM: 2022-23**

**REPORT**

Orientation program for first year B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., BCA and B.B.A students and their parents was conducted on **15/09/2022** at the college. 566 students participated in the program.

The objective of this program is to orient the students towards developing skills, building confidence, getting familiar with the Institution and competences required. The program module is based on the teaching material provided by DCE, developed by CLHRD, Mangalore. The students and parents were oriented to new systems introduced in by the state government under NEP like Open elective, UUCMS and LMS.

The parents of the fresh batch of students were also invited to give a comprehensive picture of the college.

The program was conducted in three sessions.

The first part of the program was the assembly of the first year degree students in the open air auditorium. After the Welcome address by Mr. Dinakara L, Associate Professor of Political Science, the staff members were introduced by Dr P G Maheshwari, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics. Conveners of various committees were also introduced. A complete picture of various programs, facilities, curricular, extracurricular, co-curricular activities of the college, achievements of faculty and students in various fields, best practices were given by Dr Shubha, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Botany and IQAC Coordinator. Non teaching staff was introduced by Kumari Veena, Superintendent. She gave information about various scholarships available for students. Principal Dr Y Venkateshappa, in his presidential address stressed upon ethical code of conduct and discipline and online attendance of the students. He motivated the students to utilize all the facilities available in the institution for their overall personality development. All faculty wished the students, a very happy and successful stay in the college in the upcoming years. The program was anchored by Nagaraju, Assistant Professor of Commerce. Then the students dispersed to various classrooms for icebreaking session.

Online entry survey was conducted and feedback was collected at the end of the program.

The Icebreaking session was conducted in 13 classrooms with two teachers in each classroom. The teachers interacted with each student in the session

and motivated the students to study well, and participate in the various activities which are conducted regularly in the institution. Students were informed about mentoring, statutory committees, NEP etc.,

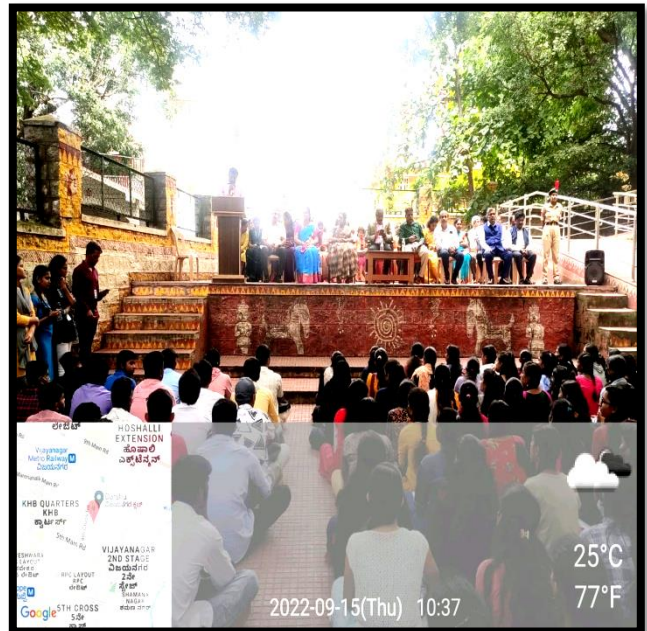

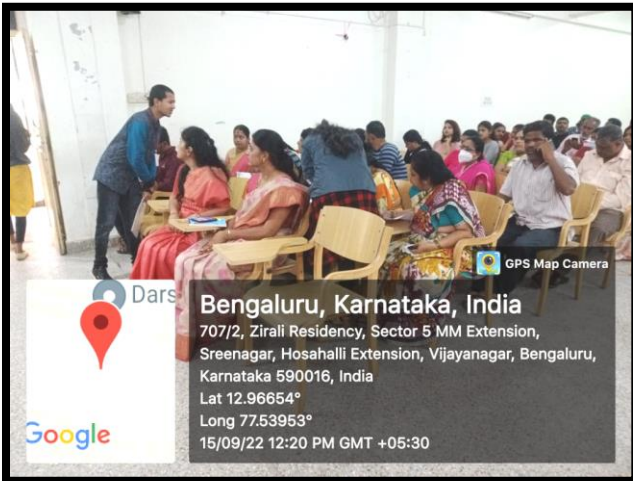
