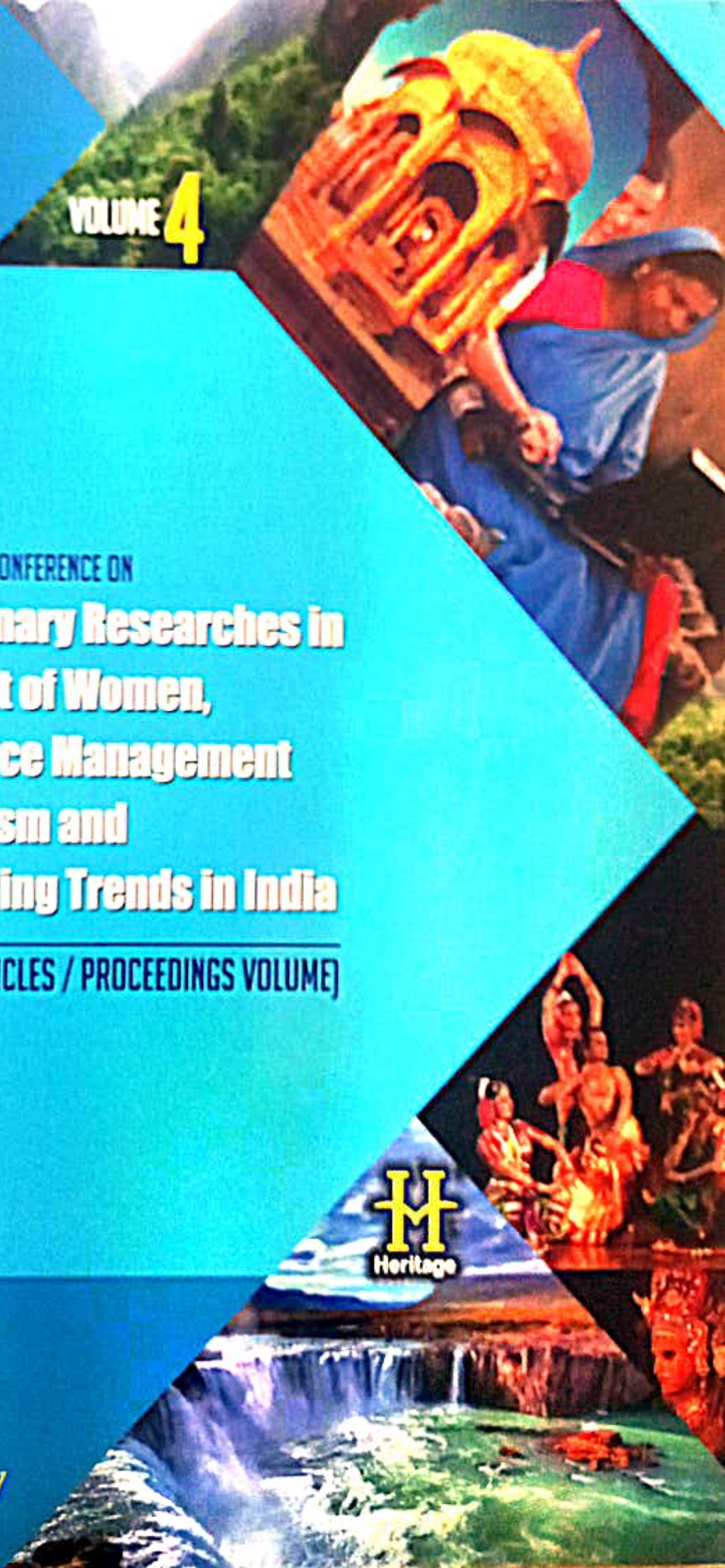

The Role of Home stays in Coorg District - A Study

Introduction:

The Coorg is a land of Green forest and mountains popularly called as The Scotland of India and South of Kashmir. The term Kodagu in Kannada is derived from Tamil word "Kodu" which means the Land of Mountains. The important Mountains are Todaiyendamol which measures 5724mtrs height, Pushpagiri 1870 meters height, Bhranghigiri 1340 meters height, Kotebetta 1620 meters height. These mountains gave birth to rivers like Kaveri, Lakshmana Teertha, Barapole, Chikhole etc. The area of Coorg District is 4102 sq kms. The Taluks of Coorg Dist. are Mercara (Madikeri), Virajpet and Somvarpet consist of 296 Villages. Coorg is stretched to South Canara in south, Hassan in north and Kerala is Neighbour state. The important Crops are Black Pepper, Coffee, Cardamom, Orange and Paddy. The 1/3 of Income tax was paid by Coorg in earlier days.

The Language of the Kodava is Kodava Takk. Kannada is an administrative language. The other languages are Tulu, Malayalam, Urdu and Tamil. The Coorg was ruled by rulers of Halepi Dynasty for about 300 years. It was founded by Muddu Raja the Halepi ruler. During the rule of Chikka Veerarajendra British rule was imposed even after 9 years after independence it has its own royal tradition. When state reorganization committee was formed it was merged into Mysore State in 1956. The Kodavas are great warriors. The leaders like field Marshall Karyappa, General Thimmaiah and others are played a vital role in the Army of India. They contributed rich in the field of sports like hockey and Athletics. They have rich oral tradition and folk song compiled in pattole and palome. Kodavas revere ancestors arms and workshop a number of deities like Iggutappa Bagawathi Muthappa, Mahadeva Subramani Ayyappa, Bhadrakali etc., Traditional Cuisine, Kadambattu etc. are local dish of Coorg.

Important tourist destinations of Coorg are:

Mercara: The headquarter of Coorg District 250 Kms. from Bangalore.

The important places are Raja seat, fort palace, Iggutappa temple, Omkareshwara temple, tombs of kings etc. They are depicted in different styles of architecture. The detail as below

- **Erappu falls:** 50Kms from Mercara (Private home stay)
- **Umbalagundi falls:** 18kms from Mercara
- **Emme madu Darga :** 12kms Mercara
- **Chelavara falls:** 34 kms from Virajpete
- **Talakaveri:** 40kms from Mercara. The birth place of river Cauvery.
- **Dodd pare waterfalls:** 25kms from Mercara
- **Nagara hole:** Rajeev Gandhi National park 96 kms from Mysore
- **Napokalu:** Bird sancutry 25 kms from Mercara
- **Pakshi Patala:** 70kms from Mercara and best tourists spot for trekking
- **Bagamandala – Triveni sangama,** 36 kms from Mercara
- **Hulital Betta** best place for trucking.
- **Dubare:** 18kms from Kushal Nagara, Elephant Camp.
- **Kakkabbe:** Best tourist place for trekking.
