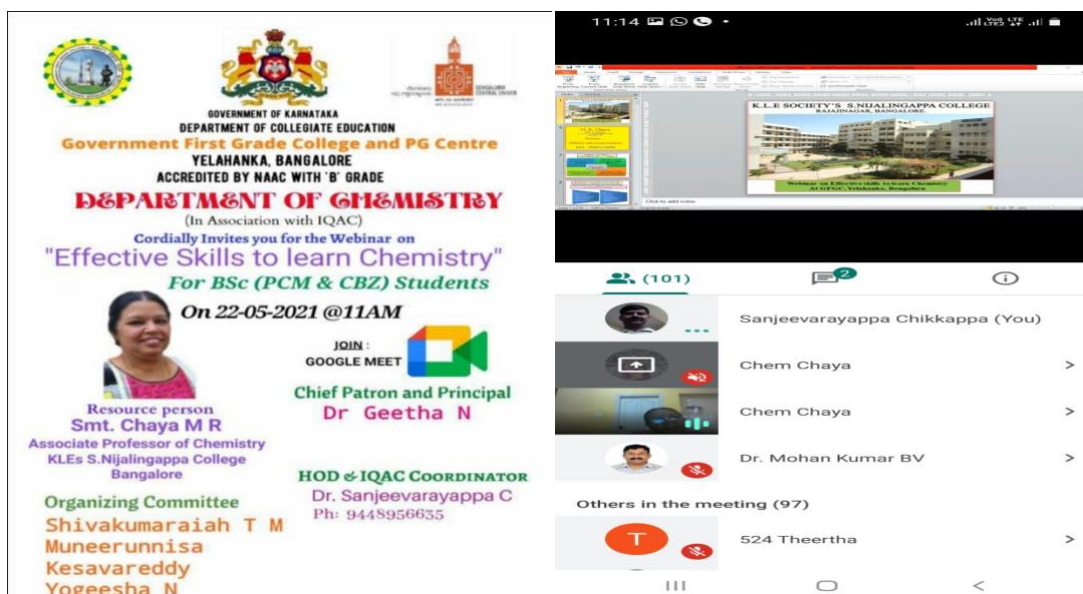

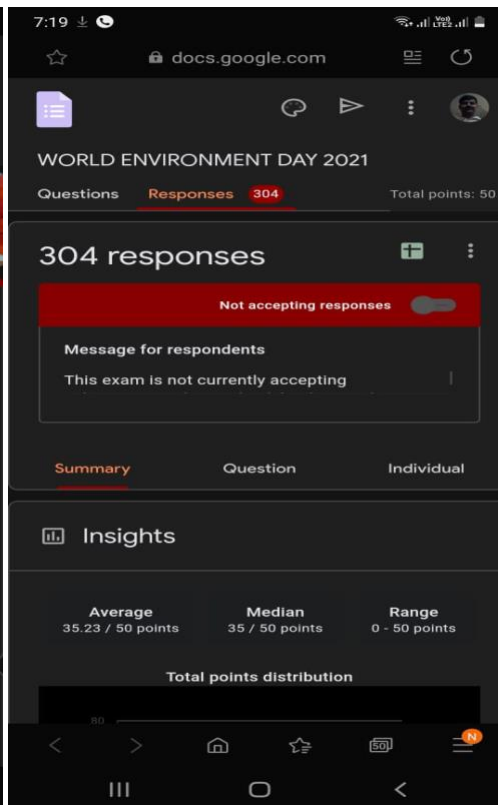
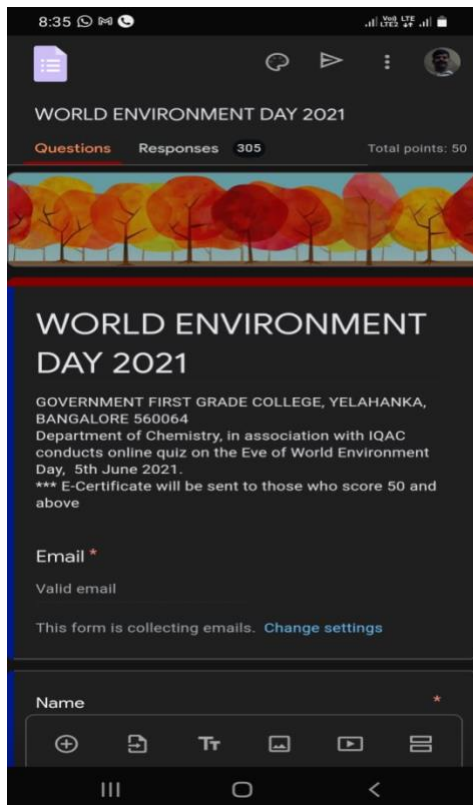


4. E-Quiz on environmental chemistry
